Pigs

Definition:

Females and males of domestic swine (of the *Sus scrofa domestica* species - swine) which include: piglets weighing less than 20 kg, pigs with a live weight of 20 kg or more but less than 50 kg, pigs weighing 50 kg and higher, i.e., sows for raising as well as other pigs, including stud boars and porkers.
