Land surface protection

Definition:

Consists of ensuring the highest possible quality of soil.

In particular through:

- 1) rational use of soil,
- 2) sustainment of natural values,
- 3) sustaining the ability to use nature in a production manner,
- 4) limiting changes to the natural environment,
- 5) maintaining ground and soil quality at required levels or better,
- 6) making ground and soil quality fulfil required standards if such are not met,
- 7) sustaining cultural values taking into account archaeological heritage.
