Gmina referendums

Definition:

Award on the official voting card positive or negative response to the question or questions, or to make a choice between the proposed variants by persons permanently residing in the territory of the gmina, having the right to vote.

The referendum is run at the initiative of the decision-making organ of a given local self-government unit, or at the suggestion of gmina inhabitants. The subject of gmina referendum can also constitute selfimposition of taxes on inhabitants with the aim of aiding social goals falling within the scope of tasks and competences of gmina organs. These issues are resolved exclusively through a referendum. Data presented since 2001.
