

# Terms used in official statistics







## Unemployed persons by LFS

Persons aged 15-74 who simultaneously fulfill three conditions:

- in the reference week were not employed;
- were actively looking for work, i.e. had carried out activities in the four-week period ending with the reference week to seek paid employment;
- were available to take up work within two weeks from the end of during two weeks after the reference veek.

Persons who were not seeking work because they had already found a job and were waiting to start it within a period of no longer than 3 months and were ready to take it up, are also included in the category of the unemployed.

- Unemployed persons previously in employment by LFS
- Active job seeking by LFS
- Economic activity by LFS

- Long-term unemployed persons by LFS
- Jobless households by LFS
- Economically active population by LFS
- Economically inactive population according to the LFS
- Young people neither in employment nor in education and training NEET (LFS indicator)
- Relation of non-working to working people (LFS indicator)
- Unemployment rate by LFS
