Water supply system

Definition:

A set of water network devices serving collection of surface and underground waters, public wells, devices serving storage and treatment of water, water supply networks, water pressure control devices.

Low-level terms:

- Capacity production of watersupply facilities of twenty-four hours
- Population connected to water supply system
- Watersupply connection
- Water supply distribution network
- Transmission (main) water supply network
- Wholesale of water/consumption of water
- Losses from water supply network
- Water delivered to households
- Water delivered for production purposes
- Water collected from intakes
- Street outlets
