Cargo transport by sea

Definition:

Carriages of cargo using owned or leased ships, under the Polish or foreign flags, during completed voyages.

The carriages include transport of cargo made in all directions of trade, i.e. brought into Polish ports from foreign ports, exported from Polish to foreign ports, transported between and among foreign ports, between Polish ports. Transport of cargo on ships chartered to a foreign ship operator is not included.
