Medium-size timber wood

Definition:

Round timber wood made from trees with an upper diameter (without bark) of at least 5 cm and a lower diameter of up to 24 cm, measured in individual units, in individual units in groups or in stacks.

Medium-size timber wood is divided into four groups based on quality and dimensions:

- a) S1 log wood,
- b) S2 piled timber wood for industrial use,
- c) S3 round timber for industrial use,
- d) S4 fuelwood.
