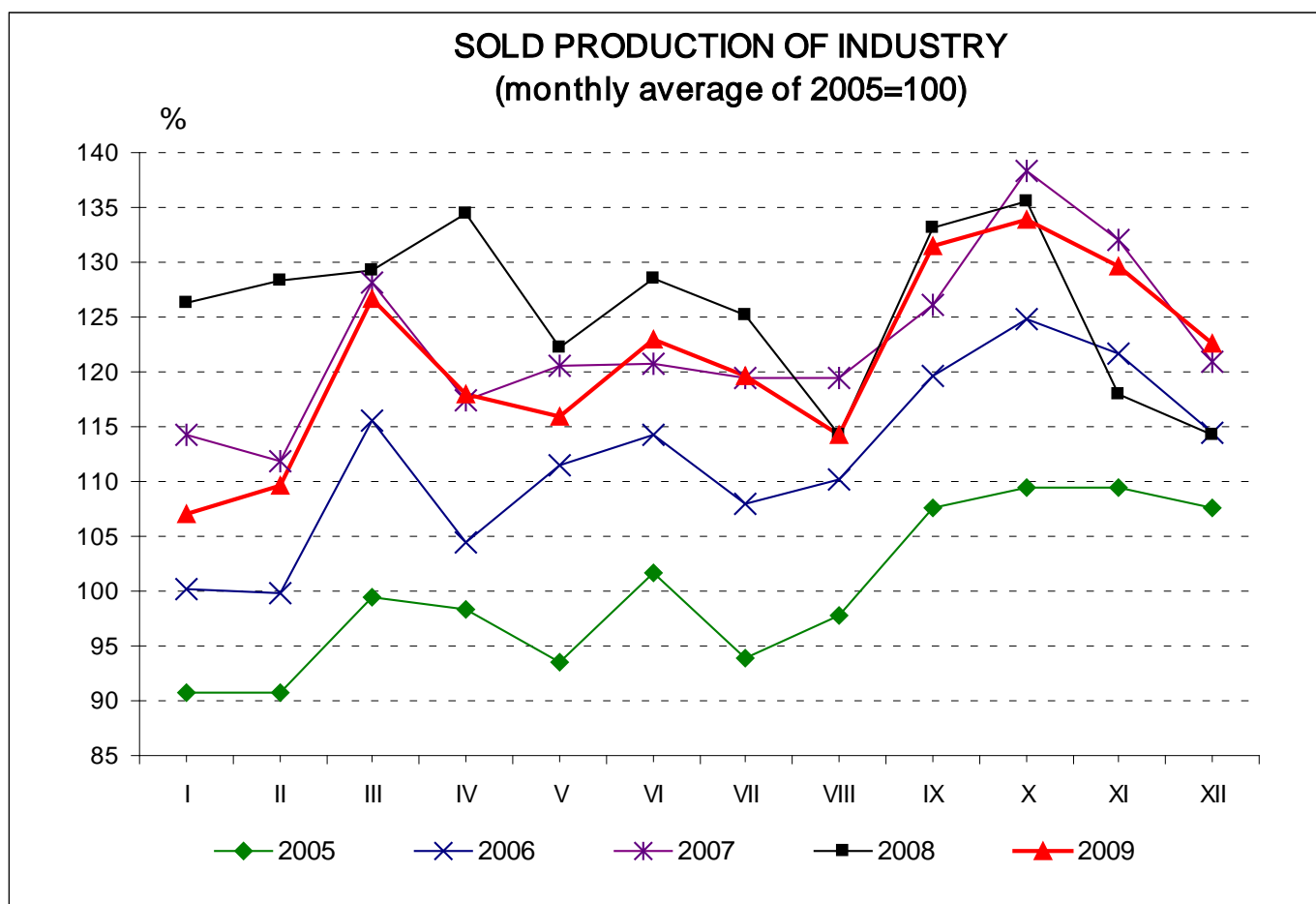

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in December of 2009 was by 7,4% higher than in the previous year and by 5,4% lower than in November of 2009. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 6,2% than in the corresponding month of 2008 and was by 2,8% lower than in November of 2009.

As compared to December of 2008, an increase in sold production was reported in 24 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 27,9%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 26,0%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 21,7%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 18,1%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 17,5% and manufacture of electrical equipment – by 15,9%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to December of 2008, was recorded in 10 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 11,8%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 4,3%, manufacture of metal products – by 2,6%.

In the period January-December of 2009 sold production of industry was by 3,2% lower than in the corresponding period of 2008.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:



According to the preliminary data, **the construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair works, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons was in December of 2009 by 3,1% higher than in the previous year and by 40,9% than in November of 2009. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, the construction and assembly production reached the level by 4,7% higher than in the corresponding month of 2008 and by 1,3% lower than in November of 2009.

As compared to December of 2008, the production grew in entities mainly involved in construction of civil engineering works – by 16,4%. However, a decrease was recorded in entities realizing mainly construction works connected with construction of buildings – by 5,4% and entities mainly involved in specialized construction activities (among others, demolition and site preparation, building installation activities, building completion and finishing) – by 4,1%.

In comparison with November of 2009 an increase of production occurred in all construction divisions and amounted to: in enterprises the basic activity of which is specialized construction activities – 52,9%, in enterprises carrying out works connected with civil engineering – 52,1% and in realizing the construction works connected with construction of buildings – 25,4%.

In the period January-December of 2009 the level of the construction and assembly production was by 3,7% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.
