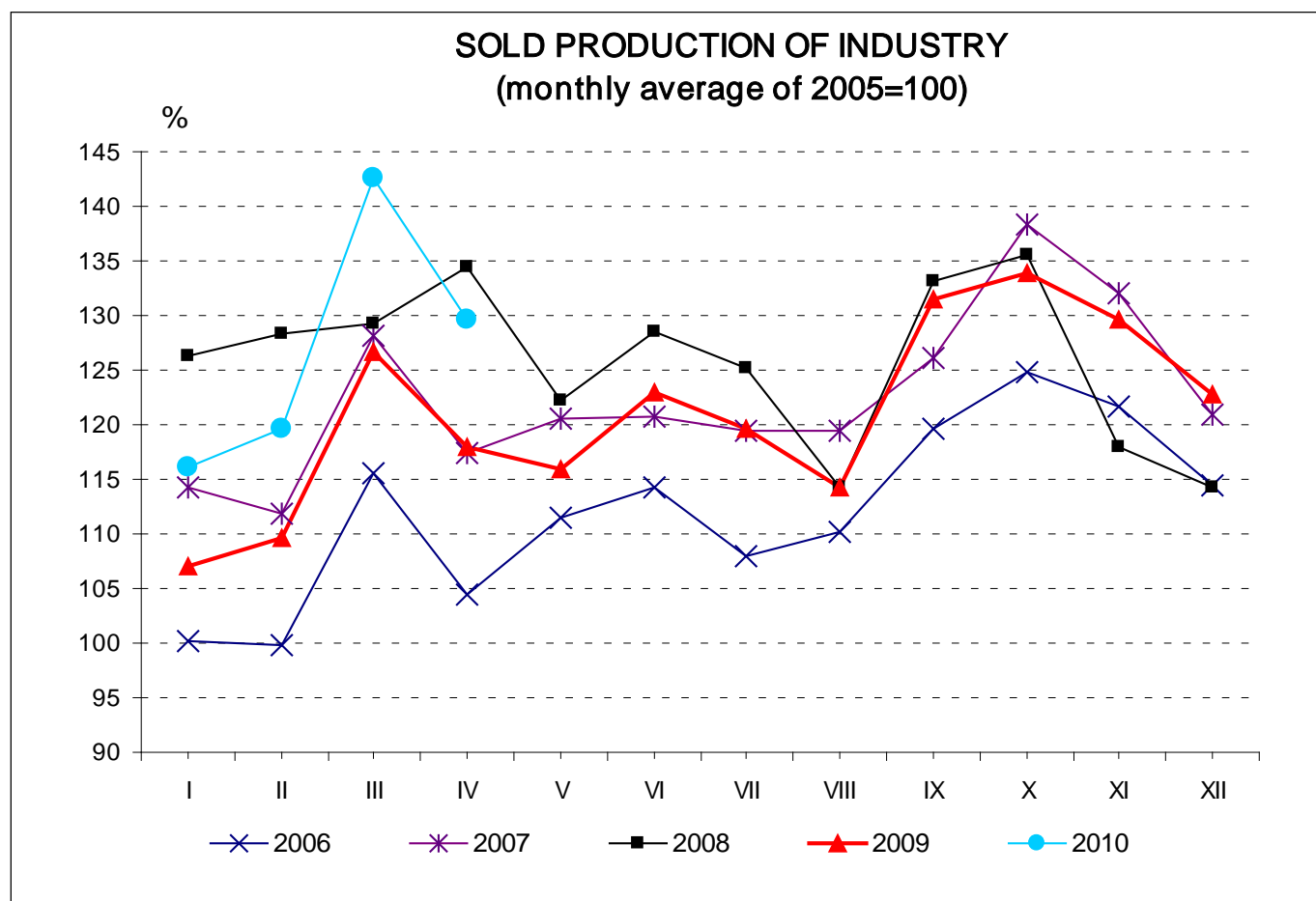

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises employing more than 9 persons) in April 2010 was by 9,9% higher than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 9,1% lower than in March 2010. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 8,8% than in the corresponding month of the previous year and was by 2,1% lower than in March 2010.

As compared to April 2009, an increase in sold production was reported in 23 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 56,4%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 43,9%, manufacture of basic metals – by 32,9%, manufacture of coke, refined petroleum products – by 19,3%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 18,1%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 17,9% and manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 14,4%. A drop in sold production of industry, as compared to April 2009, was recorded in 11 divisions, among others, in, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 26,7%, manufacture of furniture – by 15,2%, manufacture of beverages – by 11,1%, and manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 10,3%.

In the period January-April 2010 sold production of industry was by 9,4% higher than in the corresponding period of the previous year.

Indices of sold production of industry in comparison with an average monthly level in 2005 is presented in the graph below:



According to preliminary data, **construction and assembly production** (in constant prices), including investment and repair works, carried out domestically by construction enterprises employing more than 9 persons in April 2010 reached the level by 6,1% lower than in the previous year and by 18,0% higher than in March 2010. Having eliminated the influence of seasonal factors, construction and assembly production reached the level by 7,7% lower than in the corresponding month of the previous year and by 2,1% higher in comparison to March 2010.

As compared to April of the previous year, a decline of production was recorded in all construction divisions, i.e. in entities mainly involved in construction works connected with civil engineering – by 10,7%, in enterprises the basic activity of which are construction works connected with construction of buildings – by 6,1%, and in entities mainly carrying out specialised construction activities (among others, demolition and site preparation, building installation activities, building completion and finishing) – by 0,2%.

In comparison to March 2010, an increase of production occurred in all construction divisions and amounted to: in enterprises the basic activity of which are works connected with civil engineering – 34,6%, in carrying out specialised construction activities – 13,4% and in realizing construction works connected with construction of buildings – 11,4%

In the period January-April 2010 the level of the construction and assembly production was by 11,5% lower than in the corresponding period of the previous year,.
