## General government deficit and debt in 2009

On 30 September 2010, in accordance with the Council Regulation (EC) No 479/2009 of 25 May 2009 on the application of the Protocol on the excessive deficit procedure annexed to the Treaty establishing European Community, the President of the CSO provided general government deficit and debt data (fiscal notification) to the European Commission (Eurostat).

According to the EDP notification, in 2009 general government deficit was equal 97 321 mln PLN (-7,2% GDP), while general government debt amounted to 684 073 mln PLN (50,9% GDP). According to the Ministry of Finance forecasts, in 2010 general government deficit will be 112 250 mln PLN (-7,9% GDP), whereas general government debt will be 782 964 mln PLN (55,4% GDP).
