

# Consumer price indices in January 2021 (preliminary data<sup>a</sup>)

15.02.2021




According to preliminary data, in January 2021 consumer prices increased by 2,7% compared with the corresponding month of the previous year. As related to the previous month consumer prices increased by 1,2%.


Chart 1. Consumer prices\* (change in % compared with the previous period)

Chart 2. Consumer prices\* (change in % compared with the corresponding period of the previous year)


