

# Price indices of sold production of industry in July 2021

**NEWS RELEASES** 



According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in July 2021 increased compared to June 2021 by 1.2 % and compared to that recorded in the corresponding month of the previous year by 8.2%.



According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in July 2021 were higher by 1.2% compared to June 2021. The prices growth was recorded in all sections of the industry. The prices the most increased in the section mining and quarrying - by 1.4%, of which in mining of coal and lignite - by 3.0% and in mining of metal ores - by 0.4%. Prices in the section manufacturing increased by 1.3%. Different price changes were recorded in individual divisions of manufacturing. The prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 5.7%). The prices growth was recorded also, among others, in manufacture: of basic metals (by 5.1%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 2.4%), of paper and paper products (by 1.5%), of metal products (by 1.3%), of rubber and plastic products (by 1.1%), of leather and related products as well as of other transport equipment (by 0.8% each), of tobacco products as well as of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.7% each), of food products as well as of chemicals and chemical products (by 0.6% each), of textiles, of pharmaceutical products as well as of machinery and equipment (by 0.5% each), of other non-metallic mineral products and of furniture (by 0.4% each), of beverages (by 0.3%), of wearing apparel as well as of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.2% each) and of electrical equipment (by 0.1%). The prices in printing and reproduction of recorded media remained at a level similar to that recorded in the previous month. The prices in sections electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply as well as water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased respectively by 0.3% and by 0.2%.


In July 2021 the prices of sold production of industry compared to July 2020 increased by 8.2%. The prices were higher than in the previous year in all sections of the industry. The prices the most increased in the section **mining and quarrying -** by 17.6%, of which in mining of metal ores - by 35.0%, and in mining of coal and lignite - by 5.2%. The prices in **manufacturing** increased by 8.3%, with multidirectional prices movements in individual divisions. The prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 54.3%). The prices were also higher than in the year before, among other things, in manufacture: of basic metals (by 33.8%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 12.8%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 11.6%), of paper and paper products as well as of rubber and plastic products (by 7.8%), of metal products (by 7.1%), of food products (by 5.4%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 4.7%), of furniture (by 2.9%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 2.7%), of electrical equipment (by 2.4%), of other transport equipment (by 2.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 1.5%), of beverages as well as of pharmaceutical products (by 1.3% each), of textiles (by 1.0%), of leather and related products (by 0.7%), of machinery and equipment (by 0.1%). However, the prices decreased, among other things, in manufacture: of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 1.9%), of tobacco products (by 2.1%), of wearing apparel (by 2.2%). The prices in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased in annual term by 4.0% and in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 3.9%.

Among divisions of manufacturing in July 2021 the prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products both in comparison with the previous month as well as in annual term.




## Chart 1. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2020-2021 in relation to the previous period (in %)
