According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in January 2022 increased compared to December 2021 by 1.3% and compared to that recorded in the corresponding month of the previous year - by 14.8%.

Price indices of sold production of industry in January 2022 compared to December 2021

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in January 2022 were higher by 1.3% compared to December 2021. The prices increased in all sections of the industry. The largest prices growth was observed in the section mining and quarrying - by 4.6%, of which in mining of coal and lignite - by 8.1% as well as in mining of metal ores - by 1.6%. The prices increased in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 1.8%. The prices in the section manufacturing were increased by 1.1%, with multidirectional prices movements in individual divisions. The prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 4.9%). The prices were also higher than in the month before, among other things, in manufacture: of basic metals (by 2.6%), of food products (by 1.4%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 1.3%), of rubber and plastic products (by 1.2%), of pharmaceutical products (by 1.0%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.9%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.8%), of paper and paper products as well as of chemicals and chemical products (by 0.7% each), of beverages as well as of leather and related products (by 0.6% each), of metal products and of electrical equipment (by 0.5% each), of textiles (by 0.3%), of computer, electronic and optical products as well as of other transport equipment (by 0.2% each). However, the prices decreased, among other things, in manufacture: of tobacco products as well as of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers and of furniture (by 0.1% each), of machinery and equipment (by 0.3%), of wearing apparel (by 0.4%). The prices in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased bv 0.4%.

Among divisions of manufacturing in January 2022 in comparison with the previous month, as well as compared to the corresponding month of the previous year, the most increased the prices in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products

Price indices of sold production of industry in January 2022 compared to January 2021

In January 2022 the prices of sold production of industry compared to January 2021 increased by 14.8%. The prices were higher than in the previous year in all sections of the industry. The prices the most increased in the section mining and quarrying - by 24.4%, of which in mining of coal and lignite - by 29.3% and in mining of metal ores - by 22.8%. The prices in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply rose in annual term by 19.7%. The prices in manufacturing increased by 13.8%, of which the most in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 59.5%). The prices were also higher than in the year before, among other things, in manufacture: of basic metals (by 37.7%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 26.1%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 19.6%), of paper and paper products (by 17.1%), of food products (by 14.0%), of rubber and plastic products (by 12.6%), of metal products (by 11.9%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 8.9%), of furniture (by 7.0%), of electrical equipment (by 6.0%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 4.6%), of beverages (by 3.7%), of tobacco products (by 3.6%), of textiles (by 3.1%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 2.9%), of machinery and equipment (by 2.4%), of other transport equipment (by 2.1%), of leather and related products (by 1.7%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 1.0%) as well as of pharmaceutical products (by 0.7%). However, the prices decreased in manufacture of wearing apparel (by 3.0%). The prices in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased in annual terms - by 4.3%.

Chart 1. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2020-2022 in relation to the previous period






Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2020-2022 in relation to the same period of the previous year
