

Price indices of sold production of industry in September 2022

to September 2021

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in September 2022 increased compared to August 2022 by 0.2% and compared to that recorded in the corresponding month of the previous year - by 24.6%.

Prices changes of sold production of industry in September 2022 compared to August 2022

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in September 2022 were higher by 0.2% compared to August 2022. The highest prices growth was recorded in the section mining and quarrying - by 4.6%, of which in mining of coal and lignite - by 8.7% and in mining of metal ores - by 0.7%. The prices in the section manufacturing rose by 0.4%, with multidirectional prices changes in separate divisions of this section. The prices the most increased in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (by 1.8%). The prices increased also, among other things, in manufacture: of pharmaceutical products (by 1.4%), of food products (by 1.3%), of paper and paper products (by 0.8%), of electrical equipment (by 0.7%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker as well as of other nonmetallic mineral products (by 0.6% each), of printing and reproduction of recorded media and of other transport equipment (by 0.5% each), of wearing apparel as well as of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.4% each). The prices growth was also recorded in manufacture: of textiles as well as of rubber and plastic products, of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers as well as of furniture (by 0.3% each) as well as of beverages and of metal products (by 0.2% each). However, the prices were lower than in August this year, among other things, in manufacture: of tobacco products (by 0.1%), of leather and related products (by 0.2%), of basic metals as well as of machinery and equipment (by 0.3% each). The prices the most dropped in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.5%). The prices in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased by 0.3%. The prices in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply dropped by 3.7%.

Among divisions of manufacturing in September 2022 in comparison with August this year the most increased the prices in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products. The prices in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products the most dropped

Prices changes of sold production of industry in September 2022 compared to September 2021

In September 2022 the prices of sold production of industry compared to September 2021 increased by 24.6%. The prices were higher than in the previous year in all sections of the industry. The prices the most increased in the section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 71.0%. The prices in the section mining and quarrying rose by 37.8%, of which in mining of coal and lignite - by 74.7% and in mining of metal ores - by 4.3%. The prices in manufacturing increased by 19.5%, of which the most in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 62.7%). The prices were also higher than in the year before, among other things, in manufacture: of chemicals and chemical products (by 37.5%), of food products (by 29.0%), of paper and paper products (by 22.8%), of other non-metallic mineral products (by 20.5%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 18.8%), of beverages (by 14.5%), of basic metals (by 13.9%), of tobacco products (by 13.2%), of electrical equipment (by 12.0%), of rubber and plastic products (by 11.7%), of furniture (by 11.4%), of metal products (by 10.1%), of leather and related products (by 8.0%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 7.9%), of other transport equipment (by 7.5%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 7.3%), of machinery and equipment (by 6.9%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 5.0%), of pharmaceutical products (by 4.5%). of wearing apparel (by 2.4%) as well as of textiles (by 2.3%). The prices in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased in annual terms by 5.3%.


In the section manufacturing in September 2022 in comparison with the corresponding month of the previous year the most increased the prices in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products


In September 2022 the prices growth of sold production of industry was significantly lower than in the previous months
