According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in June 2017 were lower of 0.4% than in the previous month. The drop of prices was recorded in mining and quarrying of 3.7% of which in mining of coal and lignite (of 7.9%), but the growth was recorded in mining of metal ores (by 0.3%). The drop of prices was also recorded in manufacturing of 0.3% of which the biggest in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (of 4.8%). Lower than in the previous month were also prices in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products (of 1.0%), of basic metals (of 0.8%), of other transport equipment, of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 0.4% each), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker, of motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers (of 0.2% each), of rubber and plastic products, of electrical equipment, of computer, electronic and optical products as well as of furniture (of 0.1% each). Prices in manufacture of paper and paper products reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month. The growth of prices was recorded in manufacture of metal products, of machinery and equipment, of other non-metallic mineral products, of textiles (by 0.1% each), of beverages, of pharmaceutical products, of wearing apparel (by 0.2% each), of leather and related products (by 0.3%), of food products (by 0.5%), of tobacco products (by 1.2%). Prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month, however in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply prices increased by 0.1%.

In comparison to December of the previous year the prices of sold production of industry were lower of 0.9%. The prices in mining and quarrying were lower of 6.8%. The drop of prices was recorded in manufacturing of 0.8%, of which the biggest in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (of 10.4%). The drop of prices was also recorded among other things in manufacture of other transport equipment (of 3.6%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (of 2.8%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (of 2.7%), of rubber and plastic products, of furniture (of 1.6% each), of machinery and equipment (of 1.3%), of textiles (of 1.2%), of electrical equipment (of 1.1%), of computer, electronic and optical products (of 0.8%), of wearing apparel (of 0.6%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (of 0.5%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers (by 0.4%) as well as of paper and paper products (of 0.1%). Prices in manufacture of metal products reached the level similar to the one recorded in December 2016. The growth prices was recorded among other things in manufacture of pharmaceutical products, of tobacco products, of leather and related products (by 0.3% each), of food products (by 1.6%), of beverages (by 1.9%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 2.4%), of basic metals (by 3.9%). The prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply were higher by 0.8%, in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities - by 1.0%.

In June 2017 the prices of sold production of industry were by 1.8% higher than a year earlier. Prices in mining and quarrying were higher by 18.5%. The growth of prices was also recorded in sections: water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities - by 2.7%, manufacturing - by 1.2% as well as in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply - by 0.4%.

It is estimated that in June 2017 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 0.1% lower than in the previous month. The drop of prices was recorded in construction of buildings as well as in civil engineering (of 0.1% each). Prices in specialised construction activities reached the level similar to the one recorded in the previous month.

In June 2017 the prices of construction and assembly production were of 0.1% lower than in December of previous year and by 0.2% higher than in June of the previous year.
