

# Price indices of sold production of industry in January 2020

20.02.2020



According to preliminary data in January 2020 the prices of sold production of industry were higher in comparison with the corresponding month of the previous year by 0.8% and in comparison with December 2019 by 0.1%.

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in January 2020 were higher by 0.1% in comparison with the previous month. The most increase of prices was in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply by 1.1%. Prices in sections water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities as well as in mining and quarrying were also increased by 0.3% each with their growth in division of mining of coal and lignite by 1.4% and the drop of prices in mining of metal ores by 1.2%. The prices in manufacturing remained on average at a level similar to the one recorded a month ago. The prices increased ,among others, in manufacture of: pharmaceutical products (by 1.3%), of food products, of basic metals (by 0.6% each), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.5%), of leather and related products (by 0.3%), of textiles, of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 0.2% each), of other transport equipment (by 0.1%). The prices in manufacture of rubber and plastic products as well as in manufacture of electrical equipment remained unchanged. The prices decreased ,among other things, in manufacture: of other non-metallic mineral products, of metal products (by 0.1% each), of paper and paper products, of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers, of furniture (by 0.2% each), of tobacco products, of machinery and equipment (by 0.3% each), of beverages, of wearing apparel (by 0.4% each), of chemicals and chemical products, of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.6% each), of coke and refined petroleum products (by 1.0%).

Among divisions of manufacturing in January 2020 in comparison with the previous month the prices the most decreased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products by 1.0% (in comparison to January last year the price growth was recorded by 8.9%)

In January 2020 the prices of sold production of industry were higher by 0.8% than a year earlier. The prices growth was recorded in all section of industry, the most in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities by 2.7%. The prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply increased by 2.3%. The prices in section mining and quarrying rose by 1.6%, of which in mining of metal ores by 6.2% with the drop of prices in mining of coal and lignite by 2.2%. The prices in manufacturing increased by 0.6%. The largest prices growth was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 8.9%). The prices also increased ,among other things, in manufacture: of food products (by 4.5%), of tobacco products (by 4.0%), of pharmaceutical products (by 2.6%), of leather and related products, of other transport equipment (by 1.8% each), of wearing apparel, of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 1.6% each), of other nonmetallic mineral products (by 1.5%), of electrical equipment (by 0.3%). However, the drop of prices was recorded, among other things, in manufacture: of beverages (by 0.4%), of furniture (by 0.7%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media, of metal products (by 1.1% each), of textiles (by 1.3%), of machinery and equipment (by 1.5%), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker (by 1.6%), of rubber and plastic products (by 1.8%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 3.0%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 4.3%), of paper and paper products (by 4.4%), of basic metals (by 7.2%).

Chart 1. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2018-2020 in relation to the previous period (in %)




Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2018-2020 in relation to the same period of the previous year (in %)



Chart 3. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2018-2020 in relation to XII 2017 (in %)





Chart 4. Prices changes of sold production of industry by sections NACE in 2018-2020 in relation to XII 2017 (in %)


