


Price indices of sold production of industry in June 2020

According to preliminary data in June 2020 the prices of sold production of industry increased compared to the one recorded in May this year by 0.4%. However, the prices decreased compared to the same month of the previous year by 0.8%.

According to preliminary data, the prices of sold production of industry in June 2020 increased by 0.4% compared to the previous month. Prices increased in all industry sections. Prices the most increased in section mining and quarrying by 2.7%, of which in mining of metal ores - by 6.4% with the drop of prices in mining of coal and lignite by 0.3%. The prices in manufacturing increased by 0.3%. Prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 16.0%). The prices growth was recorded also, among other things, in manufacture: of pharmaceutical products (by 0.9%), of tobacco products (by 0.3%) as well as of beverages and printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 0.1% each). The prices in manufacture of electrical equipment remained unchanged in comparison with month before. However, the prices decreased, among other things, in manufacture: of computer, electronic and optical products as well as of other transport equipment (by 0.2% each), of metal products, of machinery and equipment as well as of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers (by 0.3% each), of food products (by 0.4%), of wearing apparel as well as of chemicals and chemical products (by 0.5% each). The drop of prices was recorded also in manufacture: of leather and related products and of paper and paper products as well as of furniture (by 0.6% each), of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker as well as of rubber and plastic products and of other non-metallic mineral products (by 0.7% each), of textiles (by 0.9%) and of basic metals (by 1.5%). The prices in section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities increased by 0.2% and in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 0.1%.

In June 2020 the prices of sold production of industry were lower by 0.8% than a year earlier. The deepest drop of prices was recorded in manufacturing by 1.5%. Among divisions of manufacturing the deepest prices drop was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products (by 22.2%). The prices also decreased ,among other things, in manufacture: of basic metals (by 6.9%), of chemicals and chemical products (by 5.2%), of printing and reproduction of recorded media (by 2.2%), of beverages (by 1.3%), of paper and paper products (by 1.2%), of rubber and plastic products (by 0.8%), of furniture (by 0.7%), of computer, electronic and optical products (by 0.5%). The prices in manufacture of wearing apparel remained unchanged. However, the growth of prices was recorded, among other things, in manufacture: of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker as well as of other non-metallic mineral products (by 0.3% each), of metal products (by 0.6%), of textiles (by 0.7%), of machinery and equipment (by 1.2%), of food products (by 1.5%), of electrical equipment (by 1.9%), of leather and related products (by 2.7%), of motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers (by 3.2%) as well as of other transport equipment (by 3.6%), of pharmaceutical products (by 4.0%) and of tobacco products (by 6.4%). The price increase was recorded in the section water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities by 5.8%. The prices in **mining and quarrying** increased by 3.6%, of which in mining of metal ores- by 11.6 % with the prices drop in mining of coal and lignite by 1.9%. The prices in section electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply rose by 1.9%.

Among divisions of manufacturing in June 2020 in comparison with the previous month the prices the most increased in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products by 16.0%

In June 2020, compared to the same month of the previous year, the deepest decrease in prices was recorded in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products by 22.2 %

Chart 2. Prices changes of sold production of industry in 2019-2020 in relation to the same period of the previous year (in %)





Chart 3. Prices changes of sold production of industry by sections NACE in 2019-2020 in relation to XII 2018 (in %)
