

# Foreign trade turnover of goods in total and by countries in January – August 2022

Foreign trade turnover¹ in January - August 2022 in exports at current prices amounted to PLN 1 024.3 bn, while in imports - PLN 1 083.7 bn. The negative balance reached the level of PLN 59.5 bn, while in the same period of 2021 year was positive and amounted to PLN 10.2 bn. In comparison to the corresponding period of 2021 exports increased by 22.2%, while imports by 30.9%.

## Foreign trade turnover expressed in US dollars and in EUR

Exports expressed in USD amounted to 240.8 bn, while imports amounted to USD 254.8 bn (an increase in exports of 8.6% and in imports of 16.4%). The negative balance reached the level of USD 14.0 bn, while in the same period of 2021 year was positive and amounted to USD 2.8 bn.

Exports expressed in EUR amounted to 221.2 bn, while imports amounted to EUR 234.1 bn (an increase in exports of 19.9% and in imports of 28.5 %). The negative balance reached EUR 12.9 bn, compared to a positive balance of EUR 2.3 bn in the same period of 2021.

## Foreign trade turnover of goods in total and by groups of countries

Poland has the largest share in total exports with the developed countries – 87.5% (of which EU 75.9%) and in imports – 61.9% (of which EU 52.0%), in comparison with 86.4% (of which EU 75.1%) and 64.0% (of which EU 55.5%) in the corresponding period of 2021. However, the smallest share was observed with the countries of Central and Eastern Europe, which in total exports amounted to 4.5%, and in imports – 7.3%, in comparison with 5.6% and 7.4% in the January - August 2021 period.

The negative balance was recorded with the developing countries – minus PLN 252.7 bn (minus USD 59.2 bn, minus EUR 54.5 bn) and with the countries of Central and Eastern Europe minus PLN 32.8 bn (minus USD 8.0 bn, minus EUR 7.2 bn). The positive balance was obtained in turnover with the developed countries PLN 226.0 bn (USD 53.2 bn, EUR 48.8 bn), of which with the EU countries the balance of PLN 214.5 bn (USD 50.4 bn, EUR 46.3 bn).

Note. Due to the rounding of data, in some cases sums of components may slightly differ from the amount given in the item "total".

## Foreign trade turnover by major countries

In January - August 2022 among the main trade partners of Poland a decrease both in exports and imports was not observed compared to the same period of the last year.

The turnover with the top ten of Polish trade partners in exports accounted for 65.5% (64.9% in the same period of the last year), while in total imports – 63.5% (in comparison with 64.6% in January - August 2021).

The share of Germany in exports decreased in comparison with the corresponding period of the last year by 1.1 pp and amounted to 27.7% and in imports decreased by 0.7 pp and accounted for 20.7%. The positive balance amounted to PLN 59.9 bn (USD 14.1 bn, EUR 12.9 bn) in comparison with PLN 64.7 bn (USD 17.1 bn, EUR 14.2 bn) in the same period of 2021.

## Imports by country of consignment – total and groups of counties

The highest turnover in imports by country of consignment Poland recorded with the developed countries - PLN 769.3 bn, of which with the EU - PLN 692.9 bn, compared to PLN 605.0 bn, of which with the EU - PLN 561.0 bn in the same period of 2021.

## Imports by country of consignment - countries

The share of Germany in imports by country of consignment in comparison with imports by country of origin was higher by 5.1 pp, accordingly the share of the Netherlands was higher by 2.4 pp, Belgium by 1.4 pp, Czechia by 0.6 pp and France by 0.4 pp.

In January - August this year trade turnover in goods according to the SITC nomenclature compared to the same period of 2021, reported an increase in all commodity sections both in exports and imports.

In exports the largest increase concerned mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (by 157.8%), commodities and transaction not classified elsewhere in the SITC (by 153.4%), animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes (by 87.3%), food and live animals (by 31.6%), chemicals and related products (by 30.4%), manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (by 26.2%), crude materials inedible, except fuels (by 17.8%), miscellaneous manufactured articles (by 13.8%), machinery and transport equipment (by 12.8%) and beverages and tobacco (by 6.8 %).

In imports an increase was recorded in commodities and transaction not classified elsewhere in the SITC (by 281.6%), mineral fuels, lubricants and related materials (by 110.6%), animal and vegetable oils, fats and waxes (by 90.3%), crude materials inedible, except fuels (by 34.3%), manufactured goods classified chiefly by material (by 28.8%), chemicals and related products (by 27.7%), food and live animals (by 26.4%), miscellaneous manufactured articles (by 24.1%), beverages and tobacco (by 17.6%), and machinery and transport equipment (by 12.0%).

Chart 1. Composition of exports by sections according to SITC nomenclature in January – August 2022





Chart 2. Composition of imports by sections according to SITC nomenclature in January – August 2022
