**Foreign trade turnover in total and by countries ¹
in January - September 2015**

After three quarters 2015, exports at current prices amounted to PLN 547297.5 mln, while imports amounted to PLN 538393.4 mln. The positive balance reached the level of PLN 8904.1 mln, while in the previous year minus PLN 7125.0 mln. In comparison to the corresponding period of the 2014, exports increased by 6.8% and imports by 3.6%.

Exports expressed in USD amounted to 147272.5 mln while imports amounted to USD 144858.1 mln (a decline of 12.1% and 14.7% respectively). The positive balance reached the level of USD 2414.4 mln (against minus USD 2345.0 mln in the corresponding period of 2014).

Exports expressed in EUR amounted to 131548.9 mln while imports amounted to EUR 129417.7 mln (an increase in exports of 7.2% and in imports of 4.0% respectively). The positive balance reached the level of EUR 2131.2 mln compared to minus EUR 1714.2 mln after nine months of 2014.
