

# Average paid employment<sup>1</sup> and average gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector in July 2021

18.08.2021



In July 2021, average paid employment in enterprise sector was higher by 1.8% y/y and amounted to 6361.7 thousand, while average wages and salaries were higher by 8.7% y/y and amounted to 5851.87 PLN (gross).

Data regarding the enterprise sector concerns units conducting economic activity classified into selected<sup>2</sup> kinds of activity by NACE Rev.2 and employing more than 9 persons. Data source is "Report on economic activity" (DG-1). Within the scope of this survey, for the entities with 50 and more persons employed it is a census survey, while for the entities employing from 10 to 49 persons it is a sample one<sup>3</sup>.

In enterprise sector in July 2021 average paid employment was similar to the one noted in the previous month, while average gross wages and salaries minimally increased compared to the June this year (by 0.9%)

In July 2021 **average paid employment in enterprise sector** remained at a level similar to that recorded a month earlier. In the two previous months, an increase in average paid employment by 0.3% was observed, both in June 2021 compared to May 2021 and in May 2021 compared to April 2021.

In relation of July 2021 to the corresponding month of 2020, an increase in average paid employment by 1.8% was observed.


Average paid employment after converting the dimensions of part-time employees into full-time jobs.

e to the enidemic situation and its impact on the labour market from Mai


Due to the epidemic situation and its impact on the labour market, from March to May 2020 there was a decrease in the average paid employment in enterprise sector month on month, while from June 2020 its increase began to be observed. In 2021, average paid employment changed slightly. In July 2021, compared to the previous month, average paid employment remained almost unchanged - there was its slight increase by approx. 2.4 thousand full-time jobs.

Regarding average gross wages and salaries in enterprise sector, in July 2021, compared to the previous month a minimal increase by 0.9% was noted. It was caused among others by continuation of payment of quarterly, jubilee and incentive bonuses, as well as retirement severance pay (which beside the base remuneration are also included as components of wages and salaries).

Annually (July 2021 to July 2020) average gross wages and salaries increased by 8.7%. Year before (July 2020 to July 2019) a wage growth rate of 3.8% was recorded.

In the cumulative period of seven months of 2021 average gross wages and salaries, compared to the same period of the previous year, increased in all NACE sections by between 4.1% in section "Arts, entertainment and recreation" and 11.1% in section "Other service activities", which resulted in total average monthly wages and salaries increase of 8.1%.

# **Methodological notes**

Enterprise sector concerns units employing more than 9 persons and conducting economic activity within the scope of the following areas: forestry and logging; marine fishing; mining and quarrying; manufacturing; electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply; water supply; sewerage, waste management and remediation activities; construction; wholesale and retail trade; repair of motor vehicles and motorcycles; transportation and storage; accommodation and food service activities; information and communication; real estate activities; legal and accounting activities; activities of head offices; management consultancy activities; architectural and engineering activities; technical testing and analysis; advertising and market research; other professional, scientific and technical activities; administrative and support service activities; arts, entertainment and recreation; repair of computers and personal and household goods; other personal service activities.

Labour market data on survey report DG-1 do not include persons employed under a mandate contract and contract for specified work - the detailed scope of exclusions along with methods of calculating labour market variables can be found in the explanations of the DG-1 report<sup>4</sup>.

Due to the short period in which the units provide data as part of the survey on the DG-1 form, the presented results are preliminary. In the absence of complete records as at the date of preparation of the survey, it is allowed to include estimated data, and in the event of the need to correct data disclosed in previous periods, changes are included only in cumulative data.
