# Index numbers of sold production of industry in July 2021<sup>a)</sup>

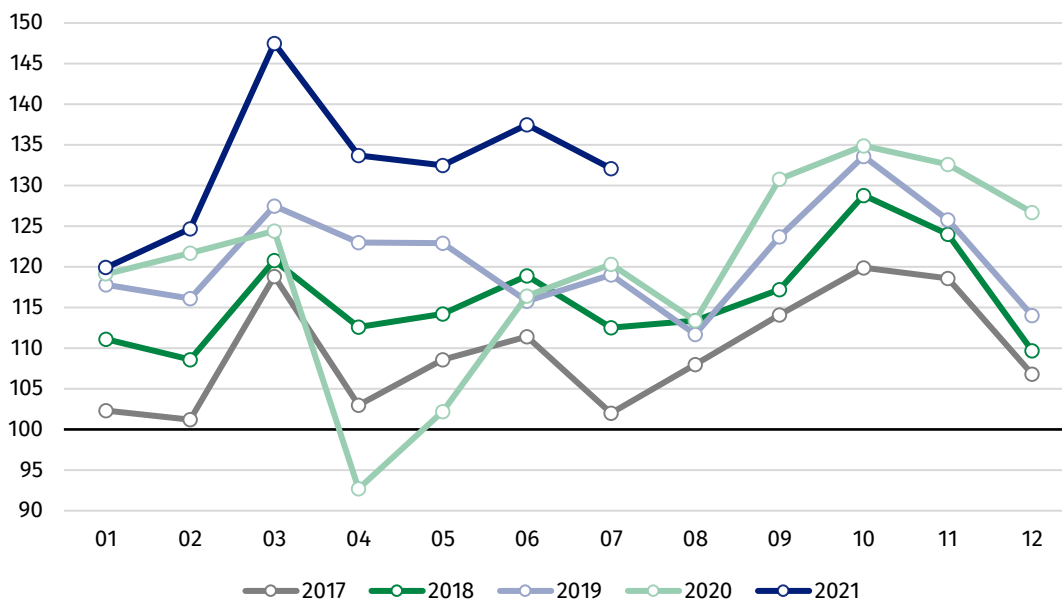
Increase in sold production of industry as compared to July 2020

In July 2021, sold production of industry was by 9.8% higher than in July 2020, when an increase was recorded by 1.1% as compared to the previous year, whereas in comparison with June 2021, it decreased by 3.9%. In the period January-July of 2021, sold production of industry was by 17.0% higher than in the corresponding period of 2020, which saw a decrease by 5.2%.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in July 2021 sold production of industry reached the level higher by 12.6% than in the corresponding month of 2020 and by 0.7% higher as compared to June 2021.

After seasonal adjustment, an increase in sold industrial production in July 2021 amounted to 12.6% per year

In July 2021, an increase of production was recorded in most of the main industrial groupings. The production of intermediate goods went up by 15.7%, energy – by 10.3%, capital goods – by 7.2%, durable consumer goods – by 6.4%. A slight decrease was observed in the non-durable consumer goods – by 0.1%.

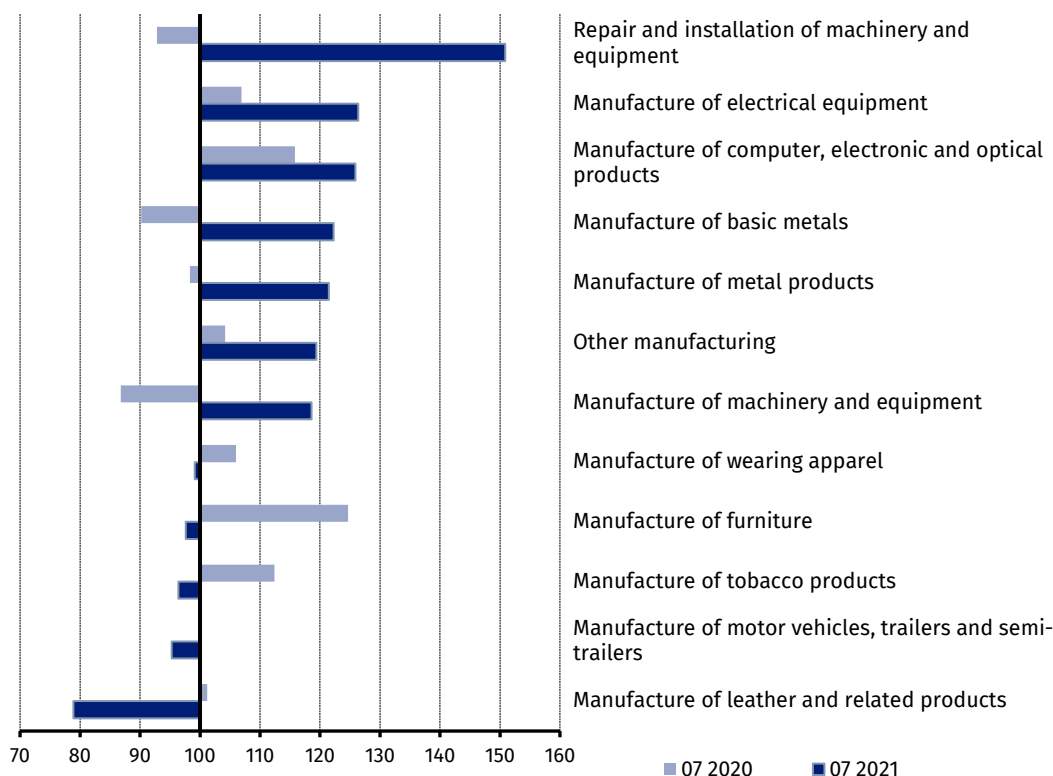

According to the preliminary data, in July 2021, as compared to July 2020, an increase in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 27 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 26.4%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 25.9%, manufacture of basic metals – by 22.3%, manufacture of metal products – by 21.5%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 18.6%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 16.6%, in manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 13.8%, manufacture of paper and paper products – by 12.2%.

A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to July 2020, was recorded in 7 divisions, among others, in manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 4.7%, manufacture of furniture – by 2.4%.

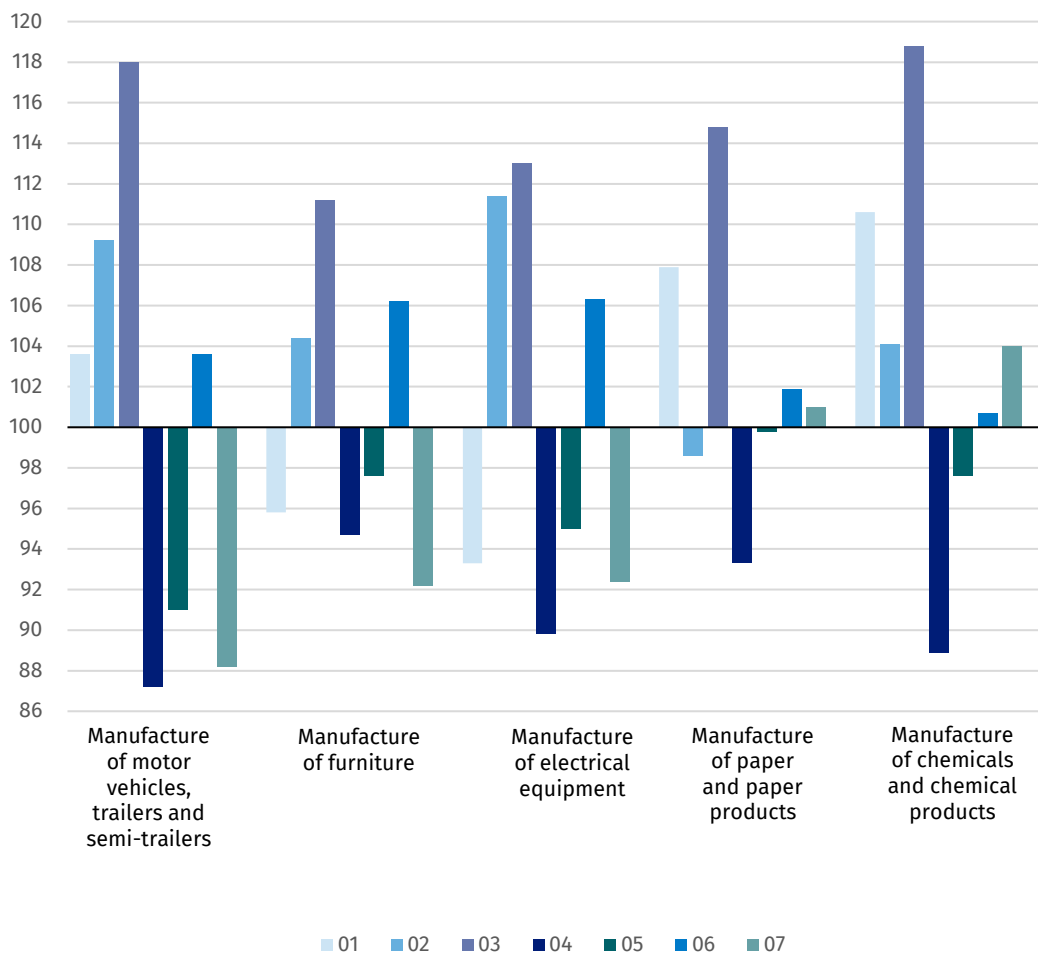
Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw an increase in comparison to July 2020, stood at 86.4%

As compared to June 2021, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in July 2021 was recorded in 26 industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 12.9%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 11.8%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 9.6%, manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 9.4%, manufacture of furniture – by 7.8%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 7.6%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 6.2%. An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to June 2021, was recorded in 8 divisions, among others, in manufacture of coke and refined petroleum products – by 5.0%, in mining of coal and lignite – by 4.1%, in manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 4.0%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 3.8%.
