

Index numbers of sold production of industry in April 2019^{a)}

Index number of sold production of industry, as compared to April 2018

In April 2019, sold production of industry was by 9.2% higher than in April 2018, which saw 9.3% increase, whereas in comparison with March 2019, it decreased by 3.6%. In the period January-April of 2019, sold production of industry was by 6.8% higher than in the corresponding period of 2018, when an increase of 6.5% was recorded.

In April 2019, an increase of sold production of industry was reported in 28 divisions of industry, as compared to April 2018

According to the preliminary data, **sold production of industry** in constant prices (in enterprises with 10 or more persons employed), in April 2019, was by 9.2% higher than in the previous year (when an increase of 9.3% was recorded) and by 3.6% lower than in March 2019. After eliminating the seasonal factors, sold production of industry reached the level higher by 6.5% than in the corresponding month of 2018 and by 0.1% higher as compared to March 2019.

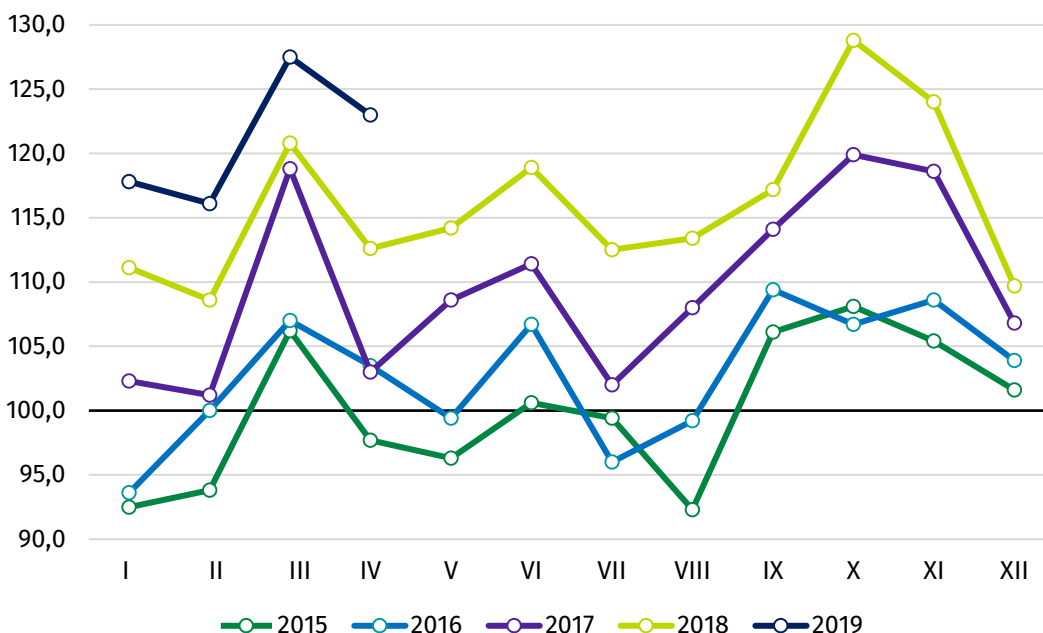
As compared to April 2018, an increase in sold production was reported in 28 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 26.6%, manufacture of other transport equipment – by 22.3%, manufacture of food products – by 13.4%, manufacture of beverages – by 12.1%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 10.6%, manufacture of metal products – by 9.6%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 9.2%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 8.0%. A decrease in sold production of industry, as compared to April 2018, was recorded in 6 divisions, among others, in manufacture of leather and related products – by 13.7%, manufacture of wearing apparel – by 10.7%, manufacture of pharmaceutical products – by 8.3%.

In April 2019, production in all main industrial groupings was higher as compared to the previous year. The production of non-durable consumer goods increased by 10.7%, capital goods – by 9.9%, intermediate goods – by 8.5%, durable consumer goods – by 7.9% and energy – by 4.2%.
