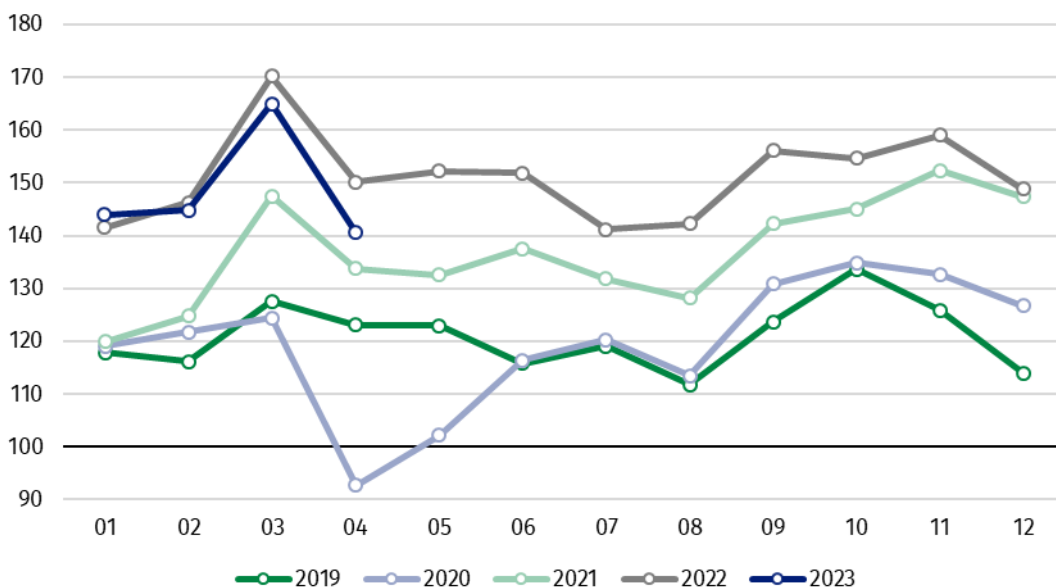
Decrease in sold production of industry as compared to April 2022

In April 2023, sold production of industry was by 6.4% lower than in April 2022, when an increase was recorded by 12.4% as compared to the corresponding period of the previous year, whereas in comparison with March 2023, it decreased by 14.8%. In the period January-April of 2023, sold production of industry was by 1.9% lower than in the corresponding period of 2022, which saw an increase by 14.9% as compared to the corresponding period of 2021.

After eliminating the seasonal factors, in April 2023 sold production of industry reached the level lower by 3.4% than in the corresponding month of 2022 and by 1.6% lower as compared to March 2023.

After seasonal adjustment, a decrease in sold industrial production in April 2023 amounted to 3.4% per year

In April 2023, among the main industrial groupings there was a significant decrease per year in the production of energy – by 14.5%, durable consumer goods – by 13.5%, intermediate goods – by 10.8% and non-durable consumer goods – by 5.3%. An increase was observed in the production of capital goods – by 7.2%.

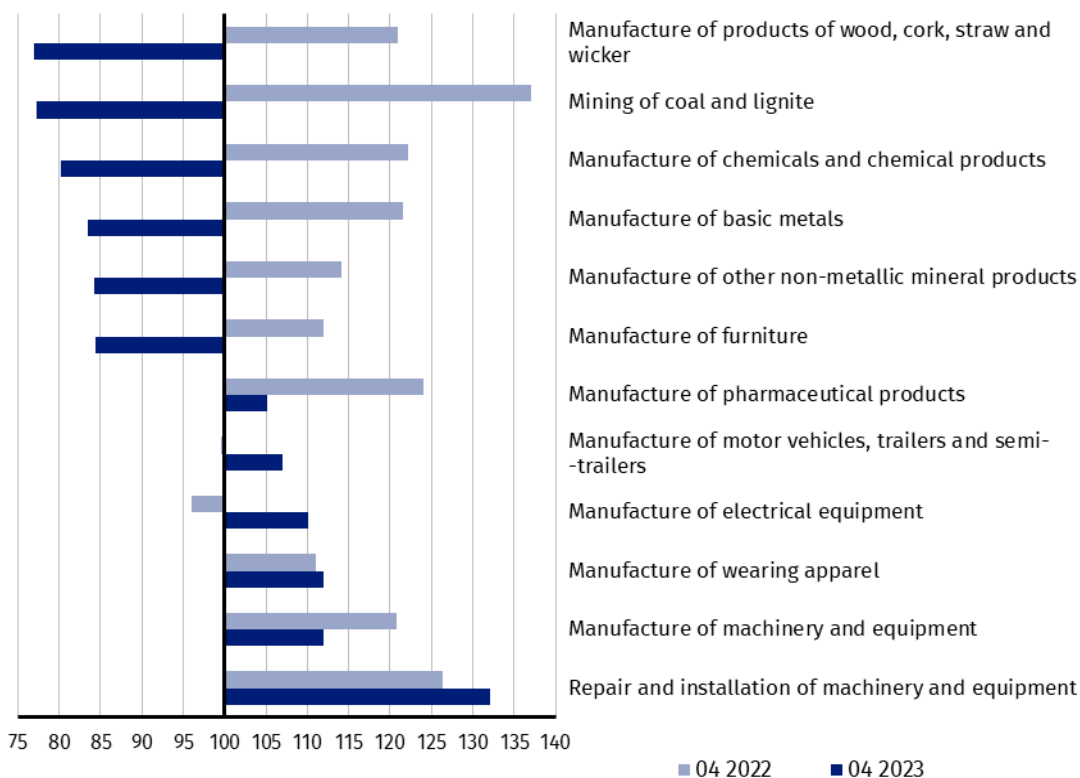

According to the preliminary data, in April 2023 as compared to April 2022, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) was reported in 25 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 23.0%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 19.8%, manufacture of basic metals – by 16.6%, manufacture of other non-metallic mineral products – by 15.7%, manufacture of furniture – by 15.6%, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 14.3%, in manufacture of paper and paper products – by 12.4%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 9.3%, manufacture of food products – by 8.6%.

An increase in sold production of industry, as compared to April 2022, was recorded in 9 divisions, among others, in repair and installation of machinery and equipment – by 32.1%, in manufacture of machinery and equipment – by 12.0%, manufacture of electrical equipment – by 10.1%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 7.0%.

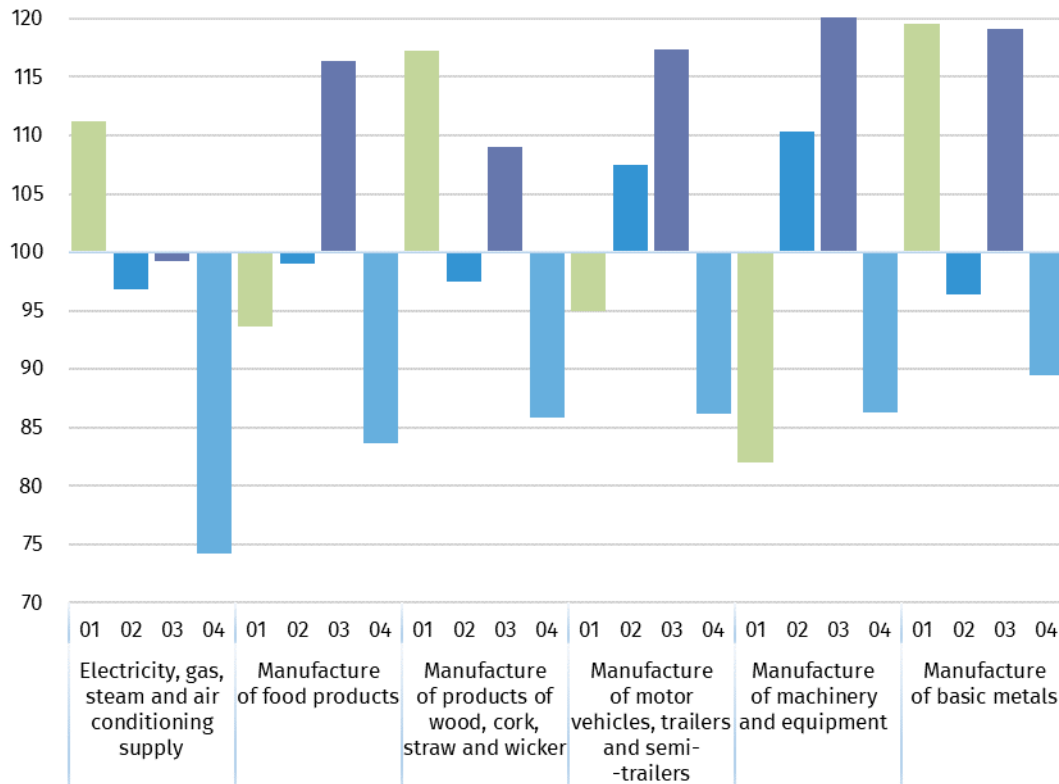
Share of production value of industry divisions, which saw a decrease in comparison to April 2022, stood at 77.6%

As compared to March 2023, a decrease in sold production (in constant prices) in April 2023 was recorded in 33 (out of 34) industry divisions, among others, in electricity, gas, steam and air conditioning supply – by 25.8%, in manufacture of electrical equipment – by 18.1%, manufacture of furniture – by 16.9%, manufacture of computer, electronic and optical products – by 16.6%, manufacture of food products – by 16.3%, manufacture of rubber and plastic products – by 14.7%, manufacture of chemicals and chemical products – by 14.2%, manufacture of products of wood, cork, straw and wicker – by 14.1%, manufacture of motor vehicles, trailers and semi-trailers – by 13.8%.
