

# Provisional estimates of gross domestic product in regional breakdown in 2021

Percentage of GDP value generated in the 5 regions in 2021

In 2021, more than 1/2 of the national value of gross domestic product was generated in 5 regions: Warszawski stołeczny, Śląskie, Wielkopolskie, Dolnośląskie and Małopolskie.

### **Gross domestic product**

In 2021, a growth of gross domestic product at current prices was recorded in all regions in comparison to 2020, the highest in Pomorskie region – by 15.8% and the lowest in Łódzkie region – by 9.8%.

The shares of individual regions in the generation of GDP were considerably differentiated in 2021 – from 2.0% in Opolskie region to 17.5% in Warszawski stołeczny region.

The value of GDP per capita in 2021 ranged from 47.5 thousand PLN in Lubelskie region (68.7% of the national average) to 141.4 thousand PLN in Warszawski stołeczny region (204.7% of the national average).

The highest level of GDP per capita obtained in 2021 in Warszawski stołeczny region exceeded almost 3-times the value of GDP per capita of Lubelskie region, where the lowest level of this indicator was noted.




In 2021, an increase of gross domestic product was recorded in all regions
