


Higher education in the 2021/2022 academic year (preliminary data)




As of 31 December 2021, there were 1,218.2 thousand people enrolled in higher education institutions in Poland, by 2.9 thousand more than in the previous year. 297.4 thousand graduates received diplomas in the 2020/21 academic year, by 3.9 thousand more than in 2019/20.

According to the POL-on register, 362 higher education institutions operated in Poland in the 2021/22 academic year. This study covers 347 HEIs which filed statistical reports.

The number of students decreased from 1,841.3 thousand to 1,204.0 thousand in the 2010/11-2019/20 academic years, but it has increased to 1,218.2 thousand people since the 2020/21 academic year. A steady decline, from 497.5 thousand people in the 2010/11 academic year to 293.4 thousand in 2019/20, was also recorded in the number of graduates (a slight increase was recorded only in the 2016/17 academic year). Their number edged up to 297.4 thousand in the 2020/21 academic year.

Compared to the 2010/11 academic year, the number of students decreased by 33.8% and the number of graduates fell by 40.2%

Students

Women accounted for 58.4% of students in the 2021/22 academic year. 783.4 thousand people were enrolled in full-time programmes (64.3% of students), while 434.7 thousand people studied part-time. First-cycle studies were chosen by 61.7% of all students (751.7 thousand people), second-cycle programmes by 22.2% and long-cycle programmes by 15.7%. The most (264.2 thousand) people studied in Mazowieckie Voivodship, while the fewest (11.7 thousand) in Lubuskie Voivodship.

64.3% of students were enrolled in full-time programmes

Business, administration and law with 22.5% of all students was the most frequently chosen broad field, followed by Engineering, manufacturing and construction (14.0% respectively), Health and welfare (12.8%) and Social sciences, journalism and information (12.3%).

84.9 thousand foreigners, including 45.3 thousand women, studied in Poland, by 5.6% more than in the previous year (this applies to people studying in Poland for at least one academic year). Most of the foreigners came from European countries, primarily from Ukraine (36.0 thousand, 40.3% of all foreigners), Belarus (11.1 thousand – 12.4%) and Turkey (2.9 thousand – 3.2%). Full-time studies were undertaken by 77.2 thousand foreigners (86.4%). Higher education institutions in Mazowieckie Voivodship concentrated more than a quarter of all foreigners (26.4 thousand).

Higher education institutions in Mazowieckie Voivoship were the most popular with foreign students

Graduates

In the 2020/21 academic year, 297.4 thousand people obtained higher education diplomas, including 187.2 thousand (62.9%) women. Most of the graduates (185.4 thousand) completed long-cycle and first-cycle programmes, while 37.7% were graduates of second-cycle studies.

Graduates most often completed their studies in the following broad fields: Business, administration and law (24.0%), Engineering, manufacturing and construction (15.7%), Health and welfare (11.2%) and Social sciences, journalism and information (10.6%).

The most of 15.7 thousand foreign graduates came from Ukraine (49.3%), Belarus (10.1%) and India (4.6%). More than half of the foreign graduates were women (56.4%). 89.2% of foreigners completed full-time studies, mostly Business, administration and law (32.4% of the total number of foreign graduates).
