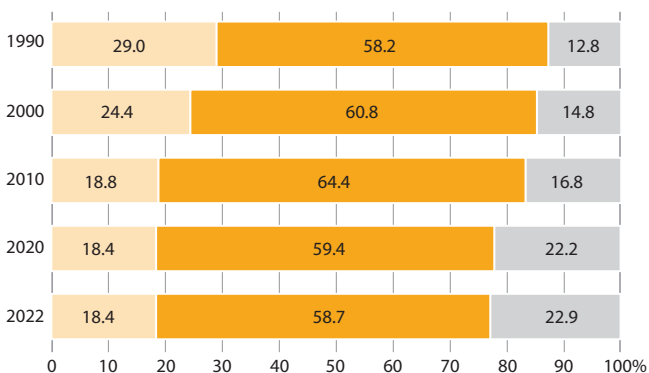

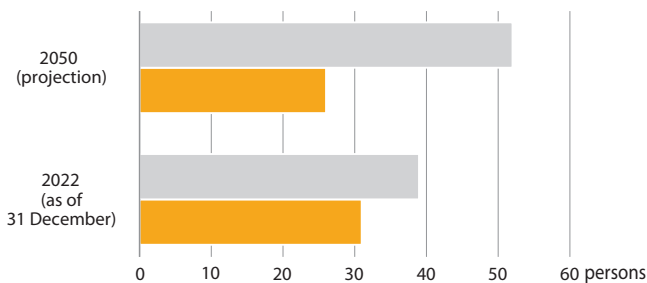
## Population by the economic age groups (as of 31 December)

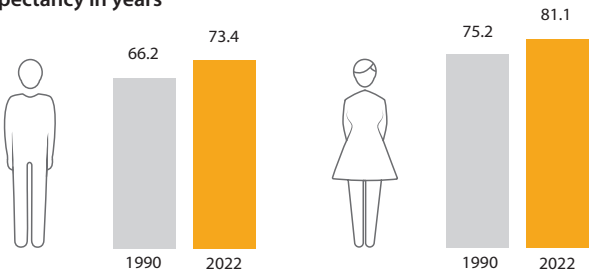
## Number of persons at non-working age per 100 persons at working age

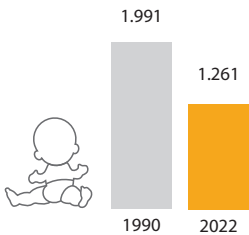

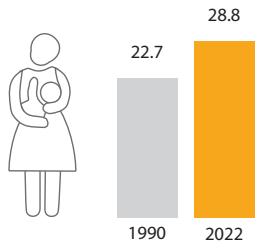

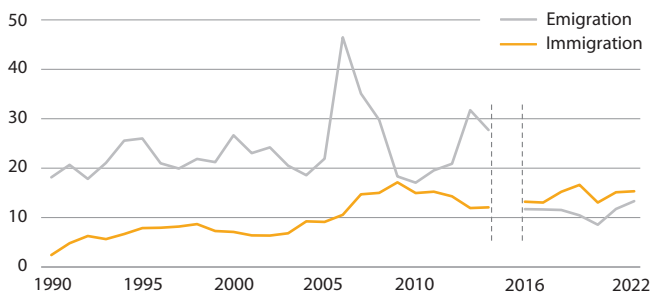


## Average age of mothers at birth of first child

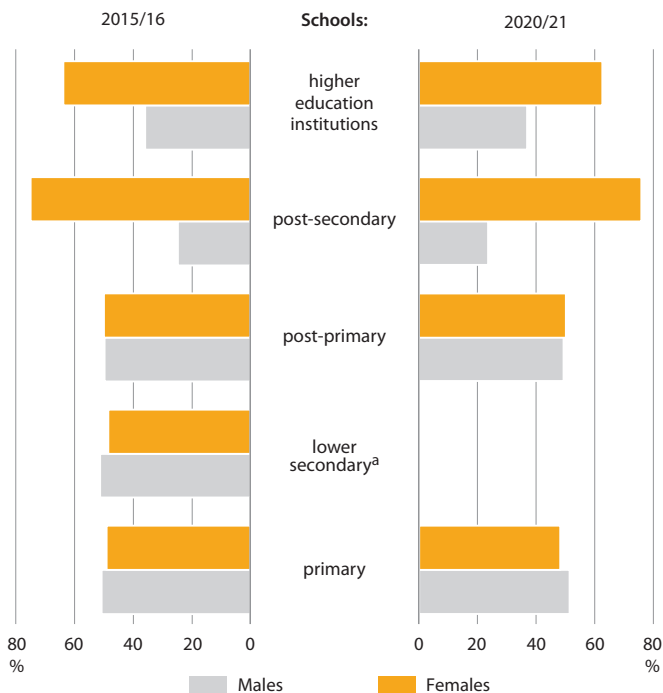

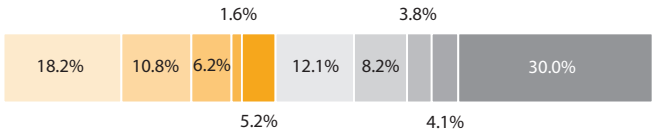

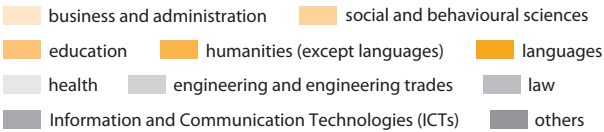

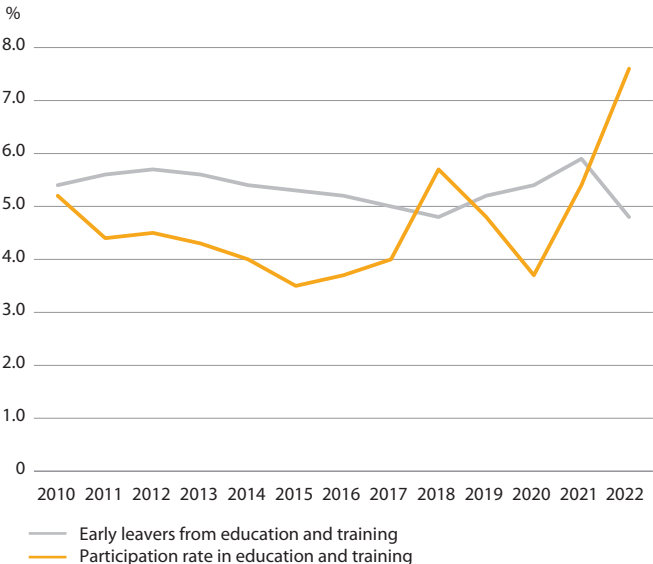
Students of higher education institutions by narrow field of education in the 2021/22 academic year

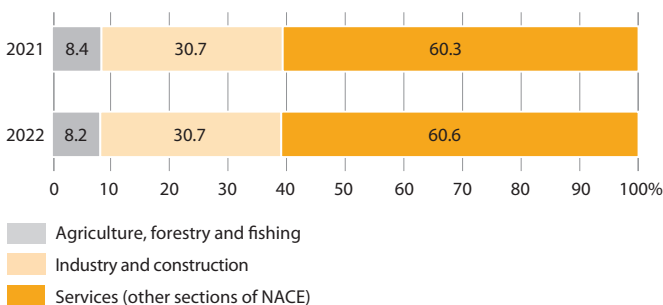

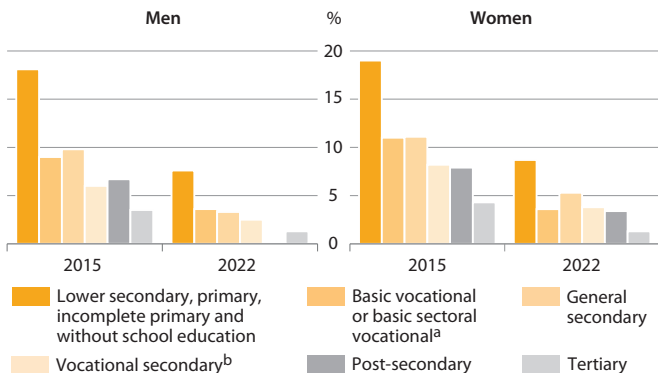

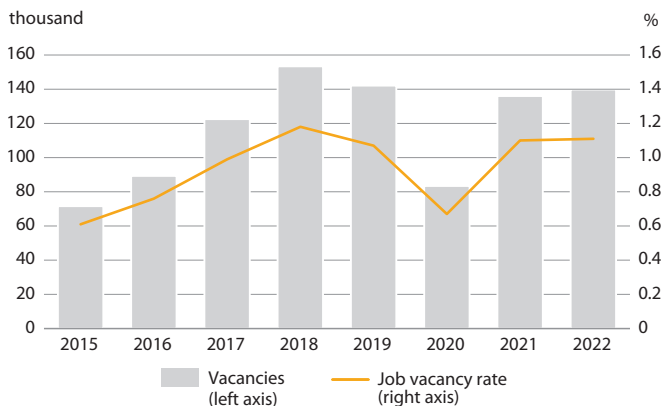

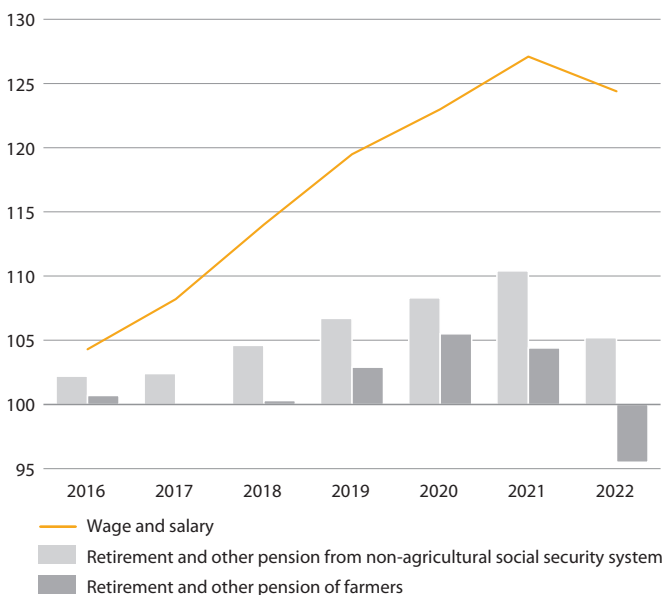

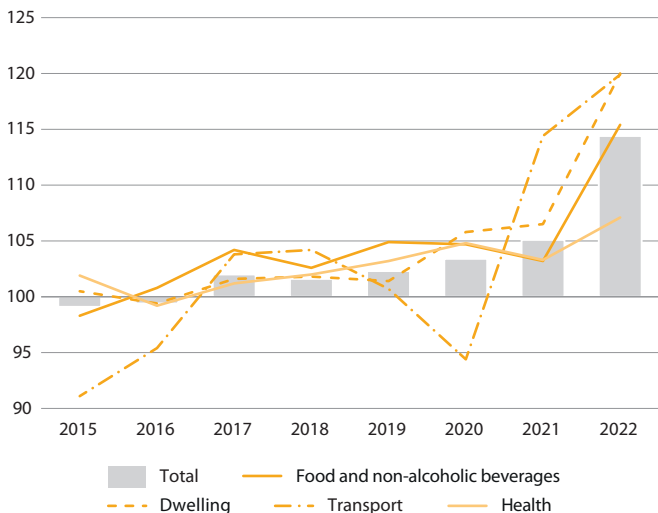

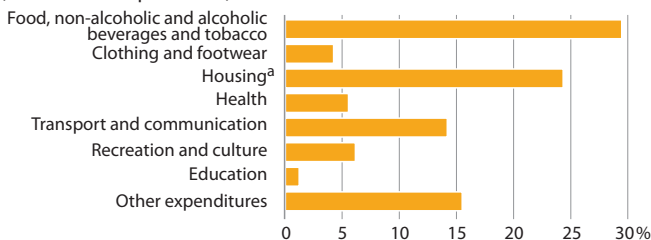

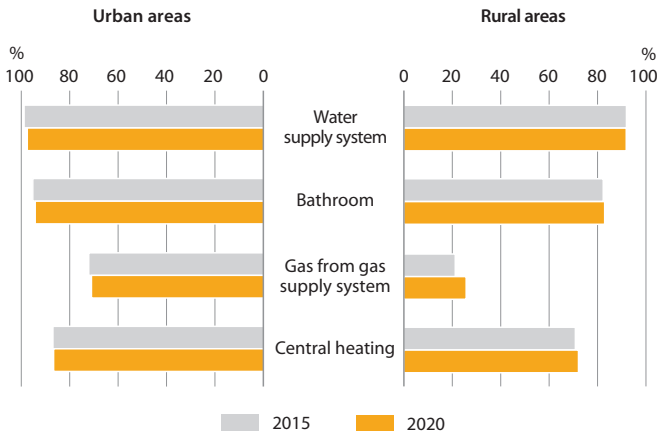

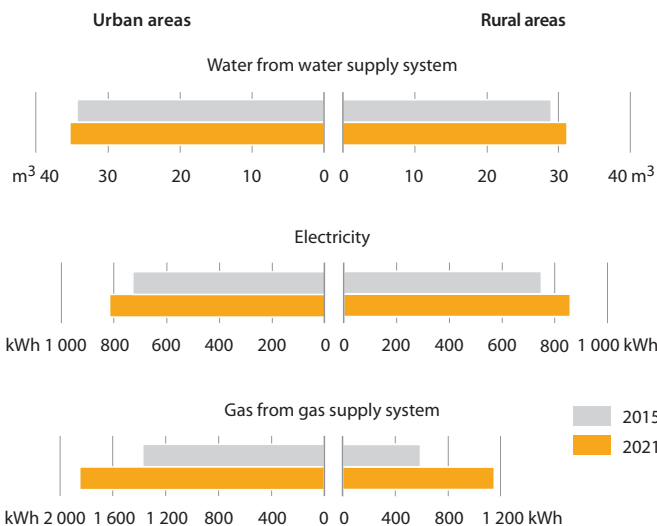

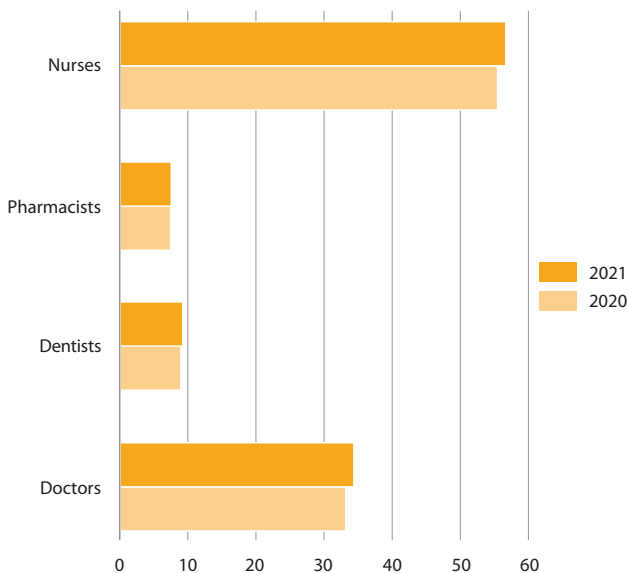

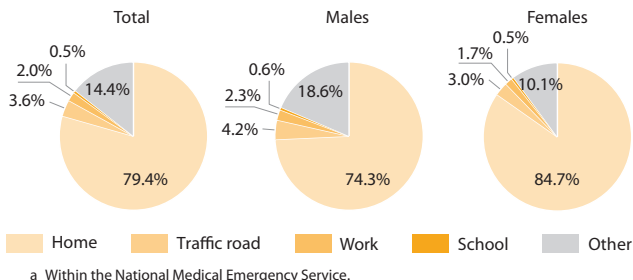

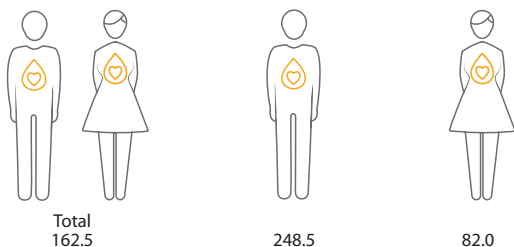

**Blood donors per 10 thousand population in 2021**

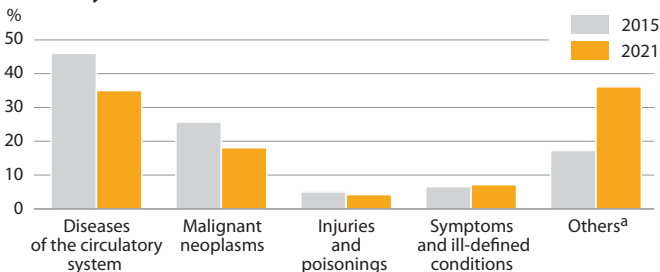


**Self-perceived health by sex in 2021**

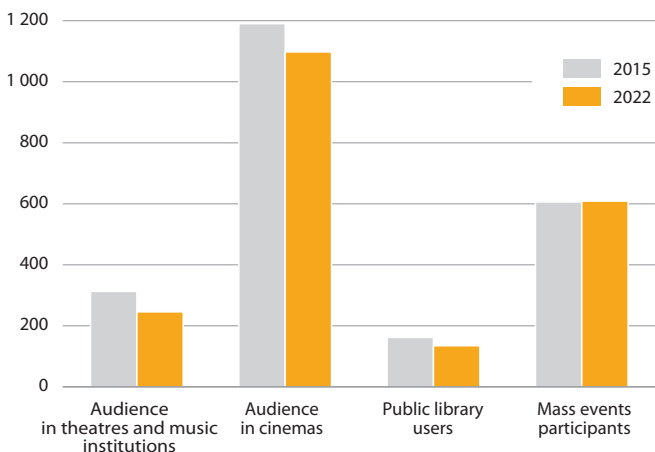

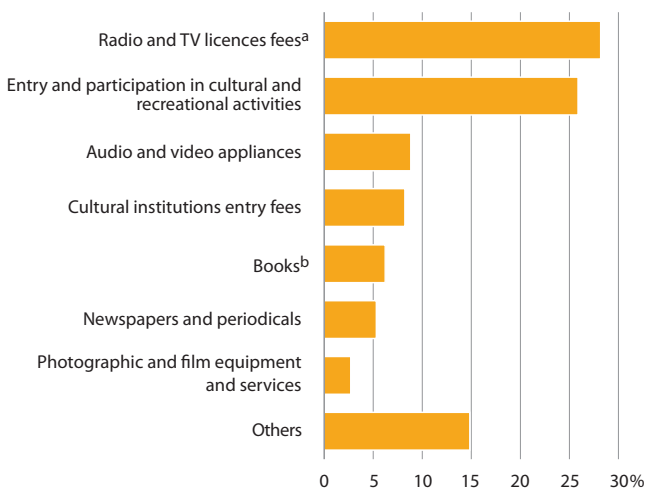

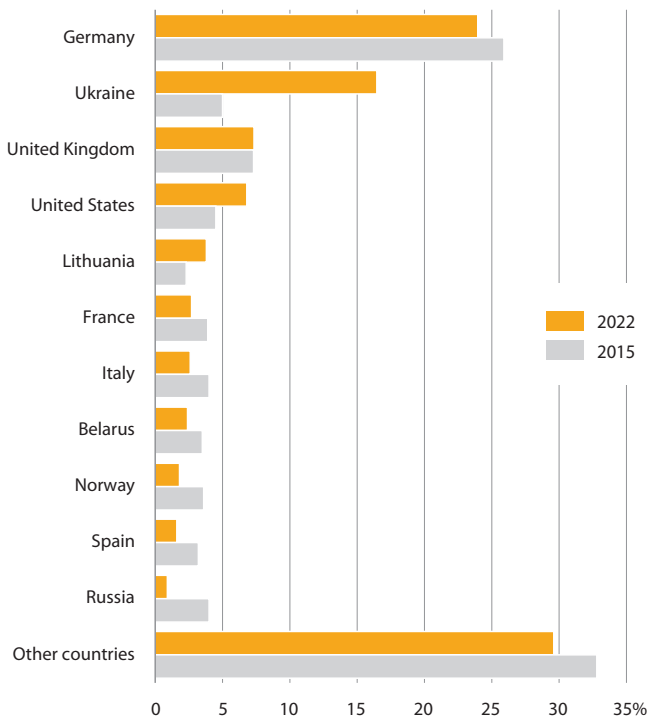

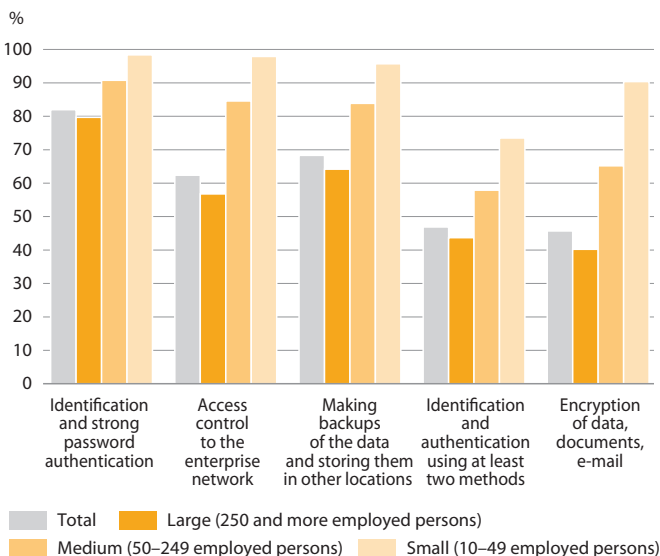

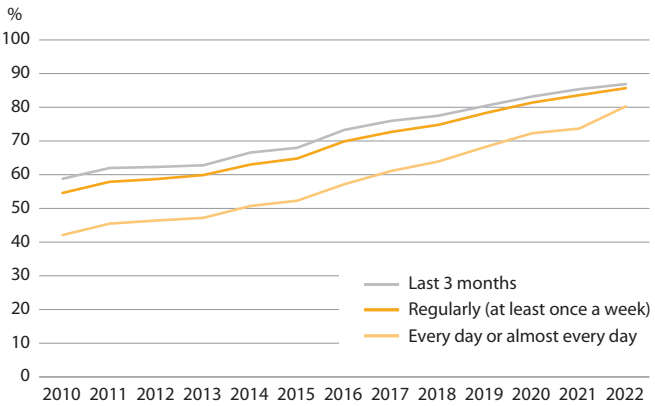

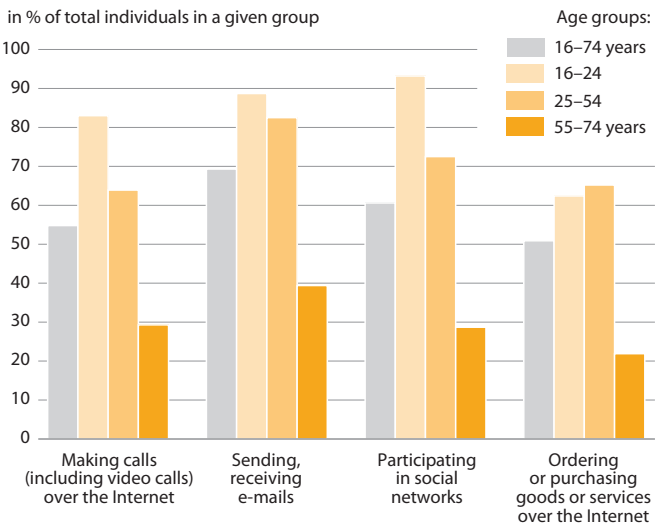

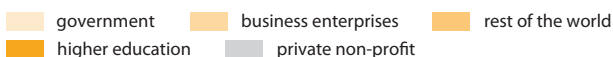

### Structure of intramural expenditure on R&D (current prices)

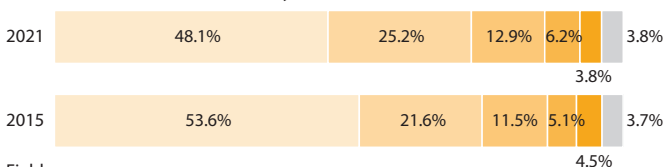

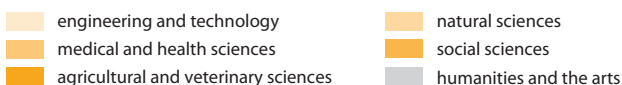

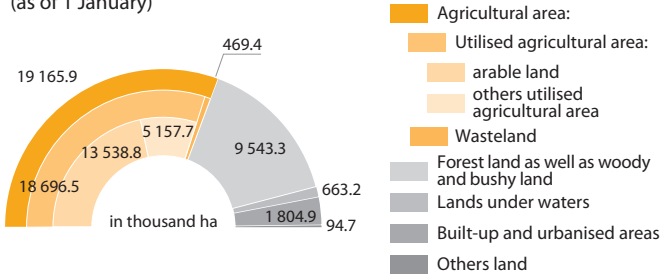

(as of 1 January)



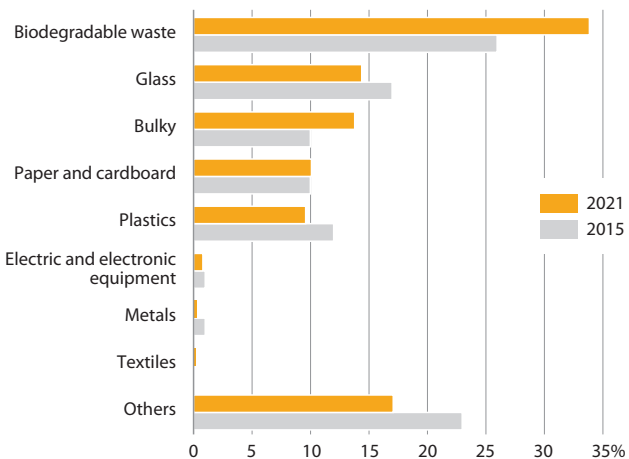

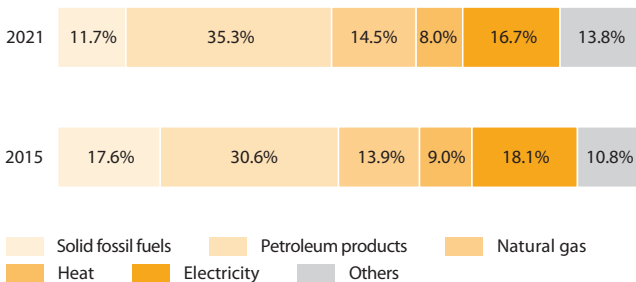

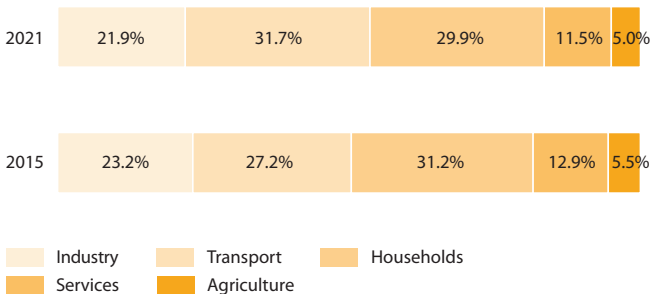

By energy carriers

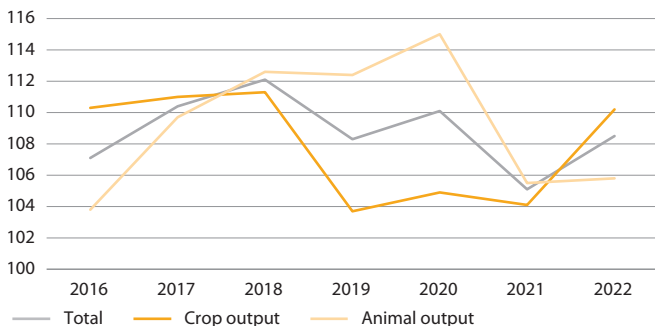

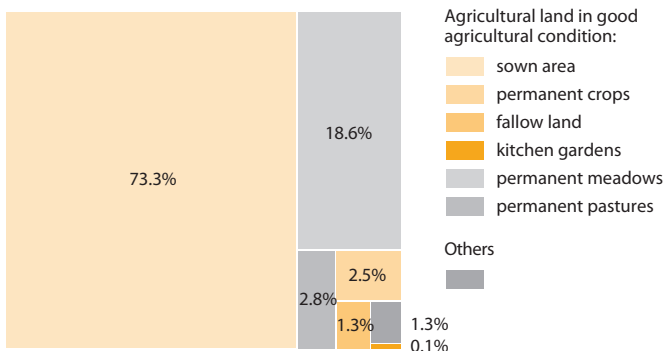

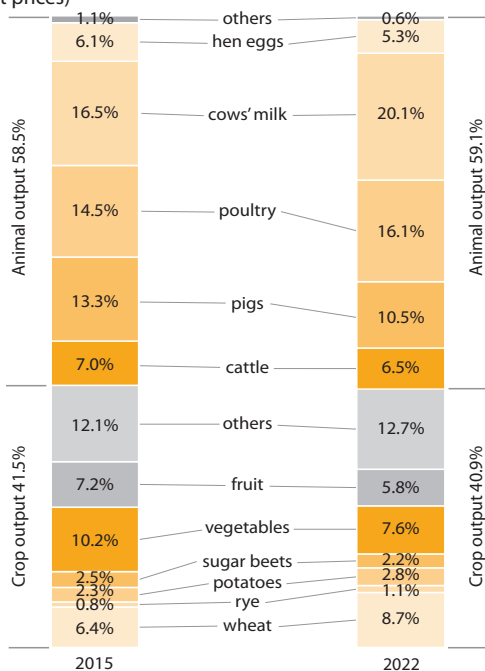

## Structure of agricultural market output by products (current prices)



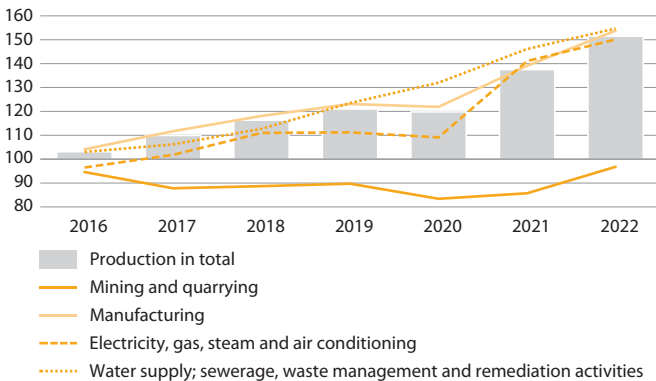

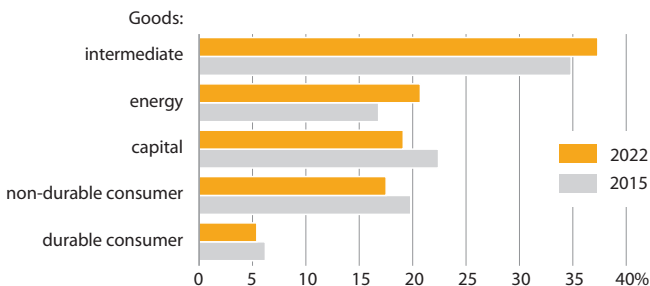

Monthly average of 2015=100



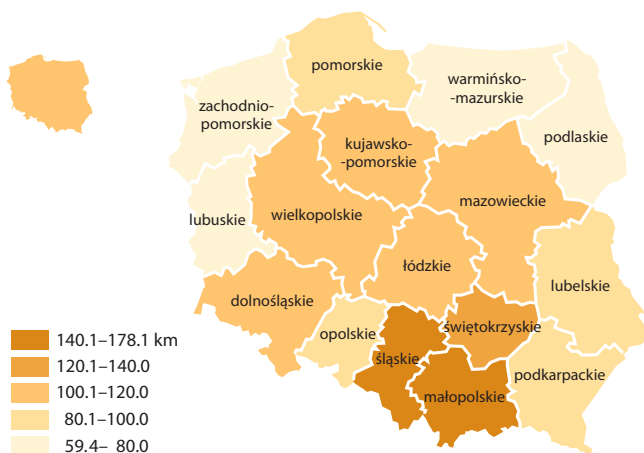
## Structure of construction and assembly production<sup>a</sup> by type of constructions (current prices)

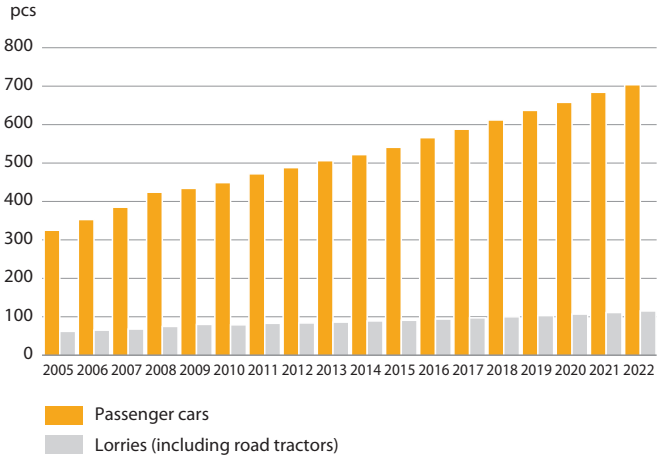

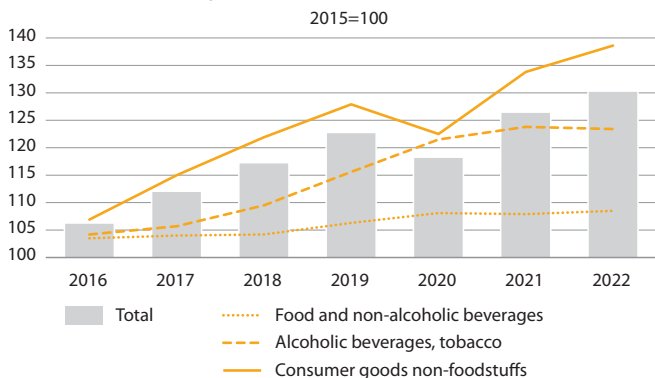

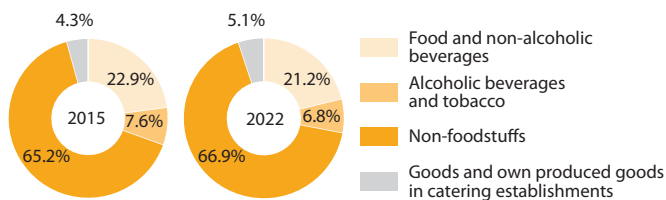

### Indices of foreign trade turnover (constant prices)

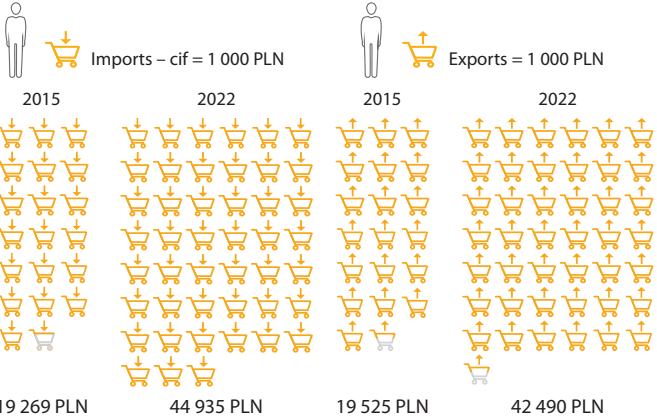


### Foreign trade turnover by groups of countries in 2022 (current prices)

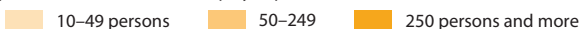

### Investment outlays in enterprises<sup>a</sup> (current prices)

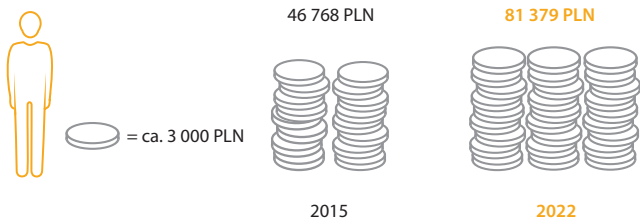

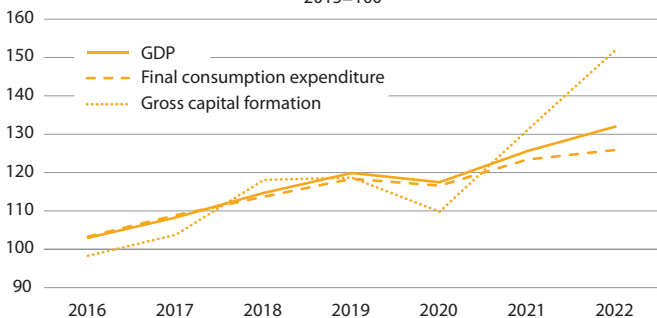

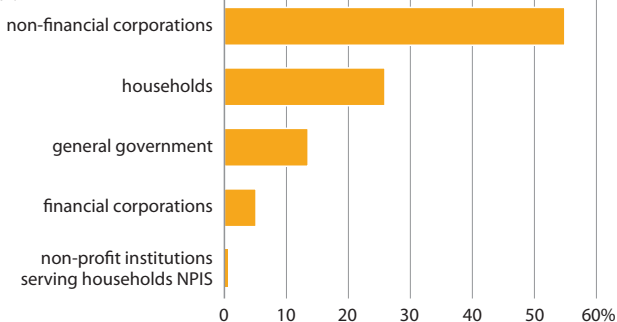

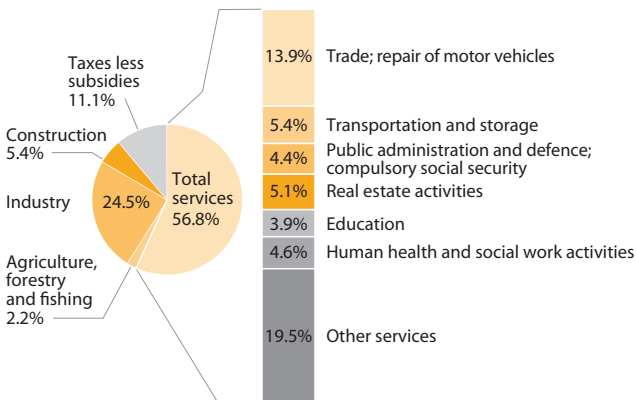
### Share of institutional sectors in generation of gross value added in 2022 (current prices)

### Structure of GDP generation in 2022 (current prices)

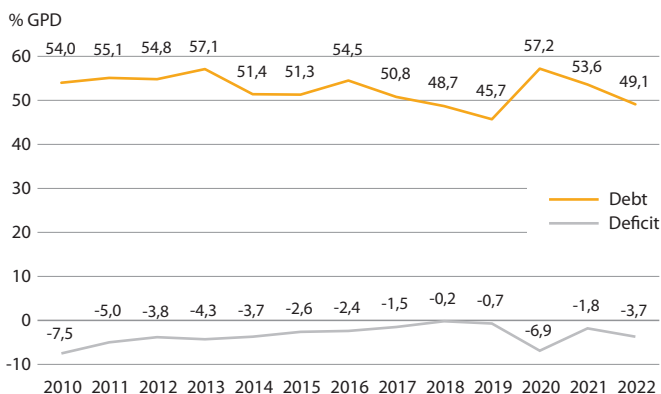

### Deficit and debt of the general government sector in % of GDP

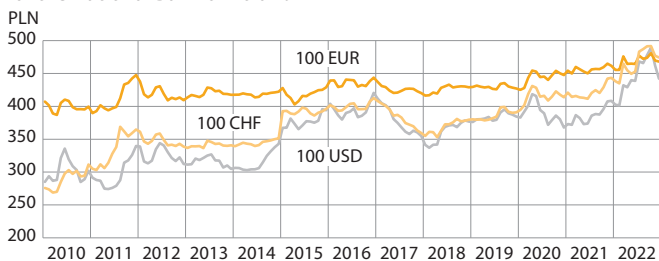

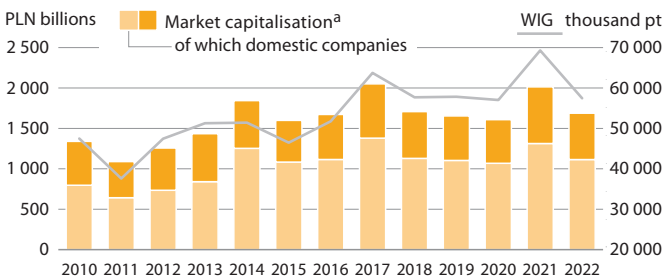

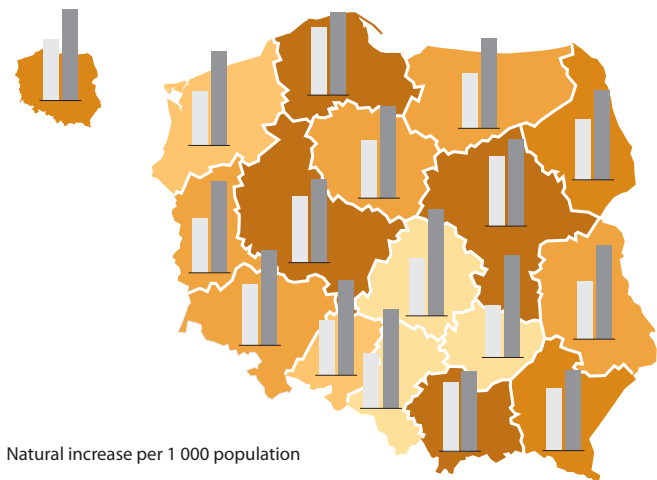

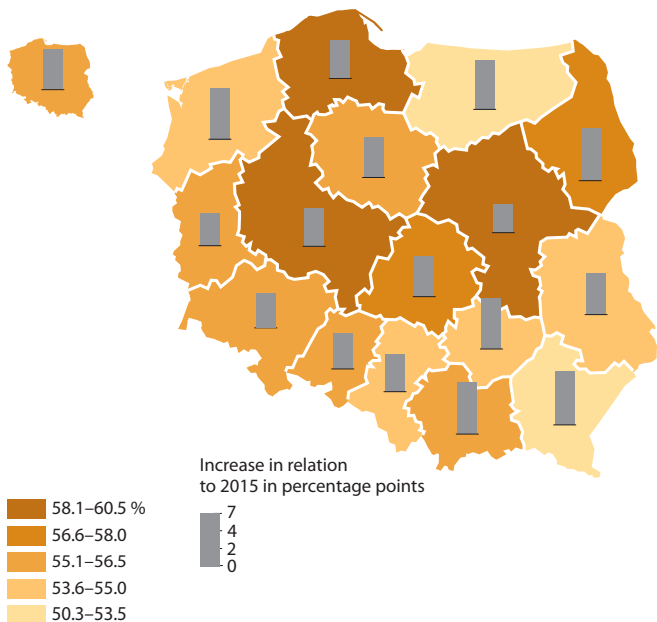

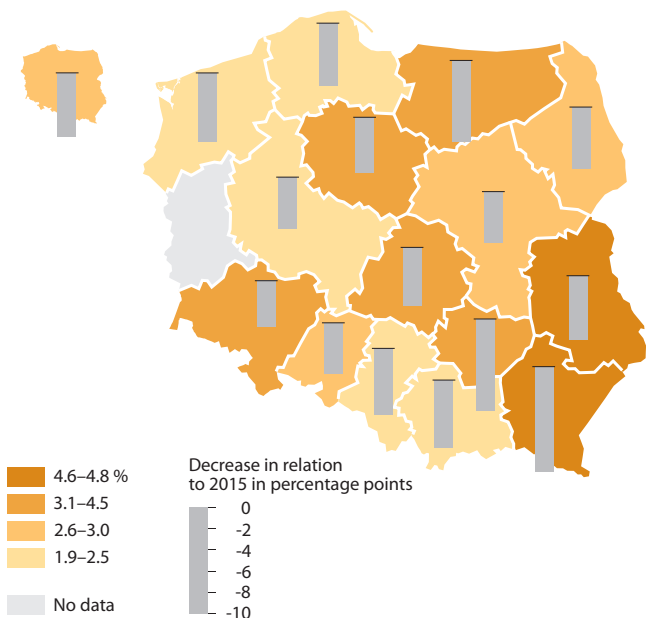


### Employment rate on the basis of LFS in 2022 (annual averages)

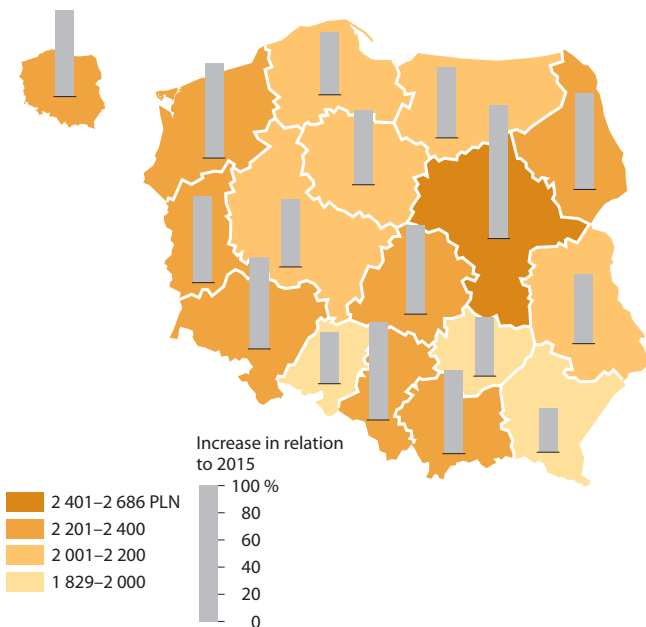

Unemployment rate on the basis of LFS in 2022 (annual averages)

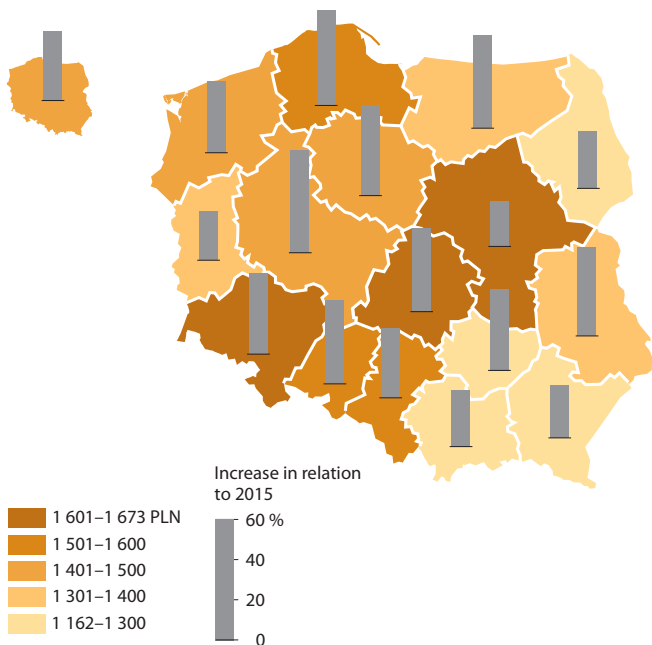


Average monthly available income per capita in households in 2022

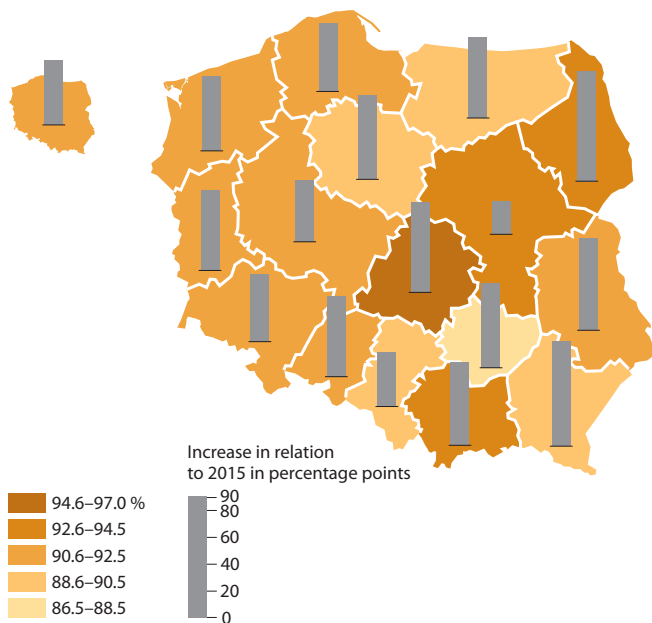

### Average monthly expenditure per capita in households in 2022

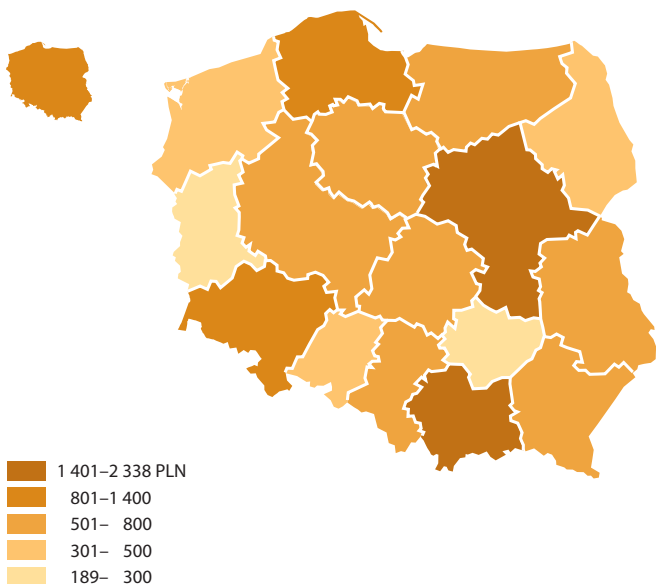


### Non-financial sector enterprises equipping their employees with portable devices enabling mobile access to the Internet in 2022

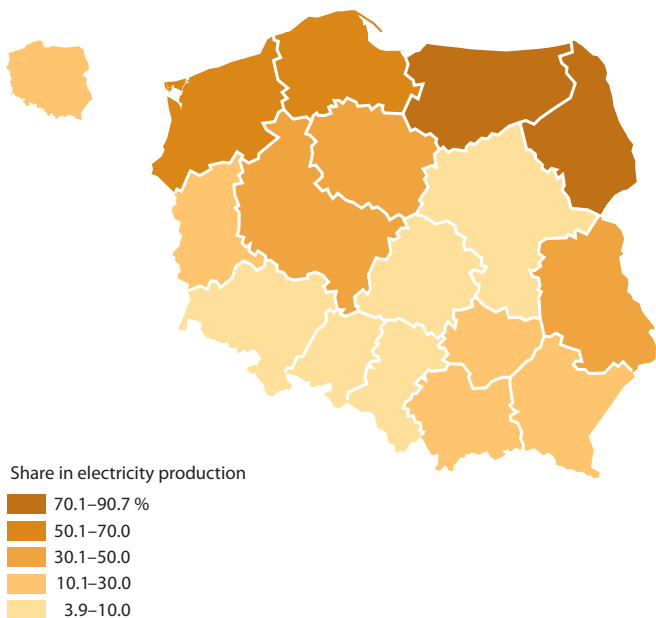

Gross domestic expenditure on research and development activity per capita in 2021 (current prices)



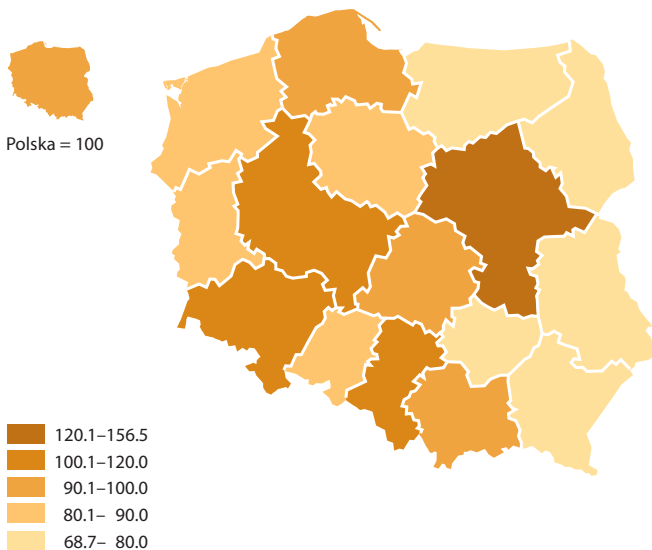
Energy from renewable sources in 2021



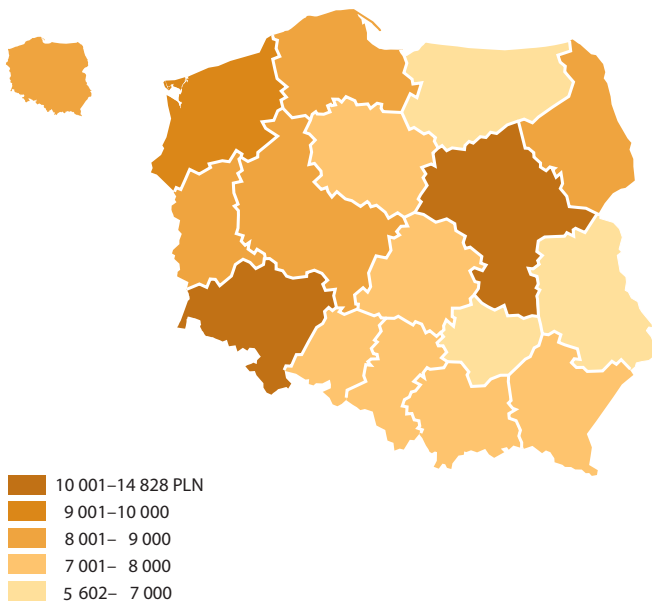

- Data concerning the population and the households were compiled on the basis of population balances based on the results of the National Population and Housing Census: for years 1990–2009 – 2002 Census, for years 2010–2019 – 2011 Census, since 2020 – 2021 Census.
- Data concerning economic activity of the population were compiled on the basis of sample Labour Force Survey (LFS) and recalculated taking into account the methodological changes in force since 2021. Data were generalised based on population balances on the basis of the National Population and Housing Census 2011.
- Source of information regarding the living conditions of the population, i.e. the level and structure of available income, expenditure as well as consumption of selected foodstuffs is a sample survey of household budgets.
- Data concerning national accounts are presented in compliance with the methodology of European System of National and Regional Accounts ESA 2010 (on the basis revision from 2014).
- Some data for 2022 are preliminary and may change in other publications of Statistics Poland.
