

# Pharmacies and pharmaceutical outlets in 2019

02.06.2020



At the end of 2019, there were operating 12.3 thousand pharmacies (generally available and dispensaries) and 1.2 thousand pharmaceutical outlets in which 59.5 thousand pharmacists and pharmaceutical technicians were employed.

## Pharmacies and pharmaceutical outlets


At the end of 2019, there were operating 12.3 thousand generally available pharmacies (decrease of 4.8% in comparison with the previous year), 24 dispensaries (as in 2018) and 1.2 thousand pharmaceutical outlets (by 4.3% less than a year earlier).

The night duties were fulfilled permanently by 2.9% pharmacies, where of temporarily by 20.8% pharmacies. The sales of medical products by mail order using the website (via epharmacies) were declared by 284 pharmacies and 5 pharmaceutical outlets.

In Poland, there were on average 2 848 persons per 1 generally available pharmacy and pharmaceutical outlet (by 132 more than in the previous year). The highest number of inhabitants per 1 generally available pharmacy and pharmaceutical outlet was recorded in Pomorskie Voivodship (3 311), while the lowest – in Wielkopolskie Voivodship (2 545).

At the national level the number of population per 1 generally available pharmacy and pharmaceutical outlet amounted to 2 848 persons


## **Employed in pharmacies and pharmaceutical outlets**

As of 31st December 2019, generally available pharmacies, dispensaries and pharmaceutical outlets employed 65.3 thousand employees<sup>1</sup>, of which 26.1 thousand pharmacists (decrease by 2.1% compared to 2018) and 33.3 thousand pharmaceutical technicians (by 0.9% less than a year earlier). The vast majority of employees were females (almost 83% of pharmacists and over 95% of pharmaceutical technicians).

Pharmacies and pharmaceutical outlets employed 26.1 thousand pharmacists and 33.3 thousand pharmaceutical technicians


Chart 1. Structure of employed in pharmacies and pharmaceutical outlets in 2019
